<b>SAMPLE Topic: Anemias: Discharge Teaching for a Client Who is Recovering from Sickle Cell Crisis</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• SAMPLE Critical Point #1: Anemia is the abnormally low amount of circulation RB, Hgb concentration, or both.</li><li>• SAMPLE Critical Point #2: When a patient is going through sickle crisis, the nurse should monitor oxygen saturation to determine a need for oxygen therapy.</li><li>• SAMPLE Critical Point #3: A patient should have their hemoglobin checking in 4 to 6 weeks to determine efficacy.</li></ul>

### **Subcategory: Advance Directives/Self-Determination/Life Planning**

#### **Topic: Professional Responsibilities: Client Advocacy Regarding Advance Directives**

- Professional responsibilities are the obligations that nurses have to their clients.
- Accountability means that nurses are answerable to themselves and others for their actions and impact on others.
- professional role accountability; role qualifications and competence; nursing licensure; personal, professional, and leadership development; nursing organizations; professional advocacy; business skills; legal practice; disruptive behavior; and ethical practice

### **Subcategory: Advocacy**

#### **Topic: Professional Practice: Acting as a Client Advocate**

- Maintaining active membership in a nursing organization to add power to the collective voice of nursing.
- Lobbying legislators in person or in writing to make concerns known to policy makers.
- Interacting knowledgeably with the media to educate the public and influence policy.

- **Quality of care**

- Management is the process of planning, organizing, directing, and coordinating the work within an organization.
- Leadership is the ability to inspire others to achieve a desired outcome.
- Effective managers usually possess good leadership skills.

#### **Topic: Leading and Managing Client Care: Resource Management**

- **Managers have formal positions of power and authority.**
- **Leaders might have only the informal power afforded them by their peers.**
- **One cannot be a leader without followers.**

#### **Topic: Airway Management: Discharge Planning for Client Who Has Tracheostomy**

- Oxygen is a tasteless and colorless gas that accounts for 21% of atmospheric air.
- Oxygen flow rates vary to maintain an SpO<sub>2</sub> of 95% to 100% using the lowest amount of oxygen to achieve the goal without risking complications.
- The fraction of inspired oxygen (FiO<sub>2</sub>) is the percentage of oxygen the client receives.

- **Leadership is the ability to inspire others to achieve a desired outcome.**
- **To lead and manage client care effectively, a nurse must develop knowledge and skills in multiple areas.**
- **leadership, management, critical thinking, clinical reasoning, clinical judgment, prioritization, time management, assigning, delegating, supervising, staff education, quality improvement, performance appraisal, peer review, disciplinary action, conflict resolution, and cost-effective care.**

- Access to reliable healthcare advice
- Treatment delivered by trusted healthcare professionals

#### **Topic: Coordinating Client Care: Case Management Approach (Active Learning Template - Basic Concept)**

- Involvement in both family and caregivers
- Information and communication that is clear and easy to understand
- Respect for individual preferences and decision-making

- **Being aware to personal reaction to stress**
- **Self-assess stress response behavior**
- **Make sure safety is established**

#### **Topic: Fractures: Identifying the Need to Revise a Client's Plan of Care (Active Learning Template - Basic Concept)**

- Checking for reasons for no suicide
- Current pregnancy
- Religious and cultural beliefs

#### **Topic: Leading and Managing Client Care: Performing Client Triage (Active Learning Template - Basic Concept)**

- **Thirty minutes prior, an injection of atropine sulfate or glycopyrrolate is administered to decrease secretions**
- **At the time of procedure, a short-acting anesthetic via iv bolus is administered**
- **A muscle relaxant is administered to paralyze muscles**

### **Subcategory: Ethical Practice**

#### **Topic: Professional Practice: Evaluating the Need for Further Staff Education (Active Learning Template - Basic Concept)**

- Obtain baseline ECG and potassium level prior
- Obtain baseline fasting glucose
- Monitor cholesterol, triglycerides, and blood glucose

#### **Topic: Professional Practice: Making Decisions for End-of-Life Care (Active Learning Template - System Disorder)**

- **Low blood pressure with possible orthostatic hypotension**
- **Decreased pulse and body temperature**
- **Hypertension can present in binge eating disorder**

### **Subcategory: Informed Consent**

#### **Topic: Professional Practice: Components of Consent (Active Learning Template - Basic Concept)**

- Concurrent use with TCAs can lead to hypertensive crisis
- Concurrent use with SSRIs can lead to serotonin syndrome
- Concurrent use with antihypertensives can cause additive hypotensive effects

### **Subcategory: Information Technology**

#### **Topic: Leading and Managing Client Care: Steps of Evidence-Based Practice (Active Learning Template - Basic Concept)**

- Used for the positive and negative symptoms of schizophrenia spectrum disorders
- Used for impulse control disorder
- Relief of psychotic manifestations

### **Subcategory: Legal Rights and Responsibilities**

#### **Topic: Professional Practice: Resources for Planning Policies (Active Learning Template - Basic Concept)**

- Avoid using with TCAs and MAOIs, cause severe hypertension
- Avoid using with TCAs and antihistamines, can result in additive anticholinergic effects
- Avoid using with alcohol, benzodiazepines, opioids and antihistamines can result in additive CNS

### **Subcategory: Performance Improvement (Quality Improvement)**

#### **Topic: Inclusive and Evidence-Based Care Environment: Strategies for Cost Containment (Active Learning Template - Basic Concept)**

- Use of cognitive therapy
- Helping the client be aware of negative thinking
- Have the client write down stressful thoughts, journaling

### **Subcategory: Referrals**

#### **Topic: The Interprofessional Team: Recognizing Need for Referral to a Speech-Language Pathologist (Active Learning Template - System Disorder)**

- Maintain a safe environment to prevent falls
- Orient to time, place, and person
- Maintain adequate nutrition and fluid balance

### **Subcategory: Clinical Judgement**

#### **Topic: Coordinating Client Care: Client Findings to Follow-up by the Case Manager**

- Administer benzodiazepines around the clock or PRN
- Obtain baseline vital signs
- Monitor vital signs and neurologic status

#### **Topic: Inclusive and Evidenced-Based Care Environment: Assessing Infection Control Precautions**

- Monitor vital signs, intake, and output and weight
- Establish realistic goals for weight loss or gain
- Reward for positive behaviors

#### **Topic: Leading and Managing Client Care: Intervening During Conflict Resolution**

- Facilitate expression of needs and issues
- Encourage to problem-solve
- Promote self-esteem
