

N434 Evidence Based Practice

Quality Improvement Paper

Each student will independently complete a Quality Improvement paper. Each student will select a nursing-specific/impact nursing practice topic of their choice. Each student will find one research article to expand on the topic of their choice. The research article must be peer-reviewed and published within the last five years. All reviewed articles must be research articles (Qualitative, Quantitative, & Mixed Methods). No Literature Reviews will be accepted.

In addition to the one research article, each student will integrate the Quality and Safety Education for Nurses (QSEN) competency of Quality Improvement into the selected topic.

The Quality Improvement Paper is divided into two submissions and two separate grades. The first submission (part one) allows grading instructors to provide feedback to the student before completing a final submission. The student will be able to complete edits per the feedback by the grading instructor and apply the feedback when completing the final submission grade (part two). See the syllabus for the part one and part two work required in submissions part one and part two.

Quality Improvement uses “data to monitor the outcomes of care processes and use improvement methods to design and test changes to continuously improve the quality and safety of health care systems” (QSEN Institute, 2020, Table 4). Quality Improvement is a key component of the nursing profession and is a continuous process.
