Main Category #1: Physiological Adaptation

Subcategory: Alterations in Body Systems

Topic: Postoperative Interventions

- Notify provider of manifestations of delayed wound healing (such as if residual limb is cool to touch)
- Monitor dressing and output from wound drain
- Maintain aseptic technique during dressing changes

Topic: Caring for a Client Following a TURP

- Avoid heavy lifting, strenuous exercise, straining, and sex for the prescribed length of time
- Drink 12 or more 8-oz glasses of water each day unless contraindicated
- Avoid nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory medications due to increased risk for bleeding.

Topic: Interventions for a Client Who Has Deep-Vein Thrombosis

- Initiate early and frequent ambulation postpartum
- Measure the lower extremities for fitted hose to lower extremities
- Use active and passive range of motion to promote circulation in the legs if warranted

Topic: Planning Care for a Client Who Is Scheduled for a Thoracentesis

- Gather all needed supplies and ensure client has signed the consent form
- Obtain reproducible x-ray to locate pleural effusion and to determine needle insertion site
- Position the client sitting upright with arms and shoulders raised and supported on overbed table or pillows and with feet and legs well-supported

Topic: Caring for a Client Following a Seizure

- Maintain the client in a side-lying position to prevent aspiration
- Assess for injuries
- Reorient and calm the client who might be agitated or confused

Subcategory: Pathophysiology

Topic: Manifestations of a Sliding Hiatal Hernia

- Heartburn may be worse following a meal
- Dysphagia may be worse following a meal
- Belching may be worse following a meal

Main Category #2: Psychosocial Integrity

Subcategory: Chemical and Other Dependencies/ Substance Use Disorder

Topic: Actions for Acute Alcohol Toxicity

- Benzodiazepines are the first-line of treatment for alcohol withdrawal
- Provide seizure precautions
- Monitor vital signs and neurologic status on an ongoing basis

Subcategory: Therapeutic Communication

Topic: Responding to a Client Who Has Depression

- Elicit and attend to the client's thoughts, feelings, concerns, and needs
- Express empathy and genuine concern for the client's and family's issues
- Intervene to promote functional behavior and effective interpersonal relationships

Subcategory: Therapeutic Environment

Topic: Actions to Take for a Preschooler Who is in an Acute Care Facility

- Explain procedures using simple, clear language.
- Encourage independence by letting the child provide self-care

- Encourage the child to express feelings

Main Category #3: Health Promotion and Maintenance

Subcategory: Ante-/ Intra-/ Postpartum and Newborn Care

Topic: Umbilical Cord Care

- Bathing by immersion is not done until the newborn's cord has fallen off
- Wash around the cord, taking care not to get the cord wet
- Move from the cleanest to dirtiest part of the newborn's body, beginning with the eyes, face, proceed to chest and wash the groin area last

Subcategory: Health Promotion/ Disease Prevention

Topic: Immunization Recommendations for a 2 Month Old Infant

- Two-month-old babies should receive the DTap vaccine
- Two-month-old babies should receive the Hep B vaccine
- Two-month-old babies should receive the Rotavirus vaccine

Topic: Teaching a Group of Older Adults About Immunization

- The primary goal of immunizations is to prevent the occurrence of infectious disease
- Educate them that older adults and immunosuppressed clients are at an increased risk
- Individuals can be carriers of disease and not have the active infection
