Complications
Constipation, Swelling, nausea
liner damage, sedation.
Fever, iv infection, thrombosis, infiltration,
Hypervolemia.

Medication Administration
taken with food
Every 4-hrs as
Needed for pain
continuous @ 125ml/hr

Contraindications/Precautions
respiratory depression, allergy,
gi obstruction, bronchospasm.
Heart failure, Hypertension, kidney disorders
gastric ulceration, pulmonary edema

Nursing Interventions
monitor pain relief,
Constipation, Blood pressure
Hr, respirations,
monitor Hypervolemia,
Hypernatremia, respiratory
distress, access output
and iv site.

Interactions
alcohol, antihistamines, atropine,
Rifampin, antivirals.
magnesium, fbc's.

Client Education
Do not take more
than prescribed, can
cause constipation and
drowsiness.
monitor Breathing
Status and iv site complications

Evaluation of Medication Effectiveness
Pain scale before and after administration.
Fluid status and electrolyte status.
