SAMPLE Subcategory: Case Management
SAMPLE Topic: Anemias: Discharge Teaching for a Client Who is Recovering from Sickle Cell Crisis <ul style="list-style-type: none">• SAMPLE Critical Point #1: Anemia is the abnormally low amount of circulation RB, Hgb concentration, or both.• SAMPLE Critical Point #2: When a patient is going through sickle crisis, the nurse should monitor oxygen saturation to determine a need for oxygen therapy.• SAMPLE Critical Point #3: A patient should have their hemoglobin checking in 4 to 6 weeks to determine efficacy.

Main Category #1: Health Promotion and Maintenance

Subcategory: Ante/Intra/Postpartum and Newborn Care

Topic: Client Education and Discharge Teaching Relieving Breast Engorgement

- Take a warm shower or apply warm compresses before breastfeeding to promote letdown and milk flow (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Empty each breast completely at feeding, using a pump if needed after the newborn has finished feeding (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Apply cool compresses after feedings (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).

Topic: Nursing Care and Discharge Teaching: Umbilical Cord Care

- Bath by immersion is not done until the newborn's umbilical cord has fallen off (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Wash the area around the cord, taking care not to get the cord wet (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Prevent cord infection by keeping the cord dry and keep the top of the diaper folded underneath it (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).

Subcategory: Health Promotion/Disease Prevention

Topic: Communicable Diseases: Immunization Recommendations for a 2-Month-Old Infant

- Fifth disease (Erythema infectiosum) is recommended (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Measles (Rubeola) is recommended (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Pertussis is recommended (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).

Topic: Epidemiology and Communicable Diseases: Teaching a Group of Older Adults About Immunizations

- Healthcare goals: Increase in adults who are immunized against pneumococcal disease (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- The community health nurse often tracks immunization schedules of at-risk populations, such as children, older adults, immunosuppressed individuals, and health care workers (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Healthcare goals: Increase in adults who are immunized against herpes zoster (shingles) (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).

Main Category #2: Psychosocial Integrity

Subcategory: Mental Health Concepts

Topic: Basic Mental Health Nursing Concepts: Assessing an Older Adult

- Use touch to communicate caring as appropriate (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Assess the client's perception of own health, beliefs about illness and wellness (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Assess for cultural factors that can impact the client's care (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).

Topic: Substance Use and Addictive Disorders: Adverse Effects of Disulfiram

- The potential for acetaldehyde syndrome with alcohol ingestion persist for 2 weeks following discontinuation of disulfiram (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Wear a medical alert bracelet (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Participate in a self-help program (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).

Subcategory: Stress Management

Topic: Stress Management: Teaching Progressive Muscle Relaxation

- Progressive muscle relaxation involves purposefully tensing specific muscle groups and then relaxing them in a progressive format (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- This can be performed with external feedback or without (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Progressive muscle relaxation is an easy technique that can be performed almost anywhere (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).

Main Category #3: Basic Care and Comfort

Subcategory: Assistive Devices**Topic: Sensory Perception: Evaluating Understanding of Hearing Aid Care**

- Collect equipment necessary to care for clients' assistive device (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Make sure these devices are available for use (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Sit and face the clients (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).

Subcategory: Nutrition and Oral Hydration**Topic: Gastrointestinal Disorders: Dietary Recommendations for a Preschooler Who Has Celiac Disease**

- Eat foods that are gluten-free (milk, cheese, rice, corn, eggs, potatoes, fruits, vegetables, fresh meats and fish, and dried beans) (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Read labels on processed products. Gravy mixes, sauces, cold cuts, soups, and many other products have gluten as an ingredient (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
- Read labels and research nonfood products (lipstick, communion wafers, vitamin supplements), which also can have gluten as an ingredient (Assessment Technologies Institute, 2022).
