Because she also liked living</p>	<p><b>Nursing Diagnosis:</b></p> <p>-Deficient fluid volume related to insufficient fluid intake as evidenced by altered skin turgor (Phelps, 2023, pg. 259-260).</p> <p><b>Goal of Teaching:</b></p> <p>-The goal of teaching is to bring awareness of the dehydration she was experiencing. This can cause major issues for the body. Unfortunately, the dehydration had already significantly harmed her as almost all her labs came back abnormal.</p>	<p><b>Intervention 1:</b></p> <p>-Administer IV fluids to the patient. Because she is not the biggest fan of drinking fluids, an IV will help.</p> <p><b>Intervention 2:</b></p> <p>-Help her find ways to flavor the water- fruits, flavors, herbs.</p> <p><b>Intervention 3:</b></p> <p>-Set a timer for every thirty minutes to help her remember to drink some fluids. This way, it can help keep her on track.</p>	<p><b>Method 1:</b></p> <p>-For one thing, I made sure to go in there and teach her verbally. Because she had a cognitive delay, it was important to use short words to help, as well as exposing her to little pieces of information at once.</p> <p><b>Method 2:</b></p> <p>-Second, I utilized the teach back method. I would pop my head in often and I would ask her what important thing she should be doing was. She would always say that she needed to drink water. I was hoping the repetition would help.</p>	<p><b>Discuss how the client/family received the teaching:</b></p> <p>-She was grateful that I told her about the water flavorings. She had no idea things like Chrystal Lite existed. She did tell me that she likes to eat a lot of sweets, so I knew this was a great segway to help with this as the water flavors could help with her sweet tooth.</p> <p><b>Identify strengths/weaknesses of the client or family in receiving teaching:</b></p> <p>-As previously mentioned, her dementia may cause her to not remember this information that I gave her.</p> <p><b>Suggest modifications to improve teaching plan (what would have improved the plan?):</b></p> <p>-I should have given her</p>

independently with some assistance, she realized that if she did not get the help, she could possibly get much worse to the point of needing to live in a nursing home (Nortje, 2024).
