Provide information to husband/caregiver regarding support groups	
Assess circulation, motion, and sensation of right hand	
Evaluate client for nonverbal pain cues and administer ibuprofen as needed	
Assist client with ADLs, such as toileting, bathing, feeding, and dressing	
Provide music therapy	
Initiate elopement precautions	
Redirect client when they try to leave the unit	
Administer prescribed medications	
Place a bed alarm on client's bed to decrease risk for falls	
Minimize environmental stimuli	

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
