Main Category #1: Safety and Infection Control
Subcategory: Accident/Error/Injury Prevention
Topic: Nursing Care and Discharge Teaching: Car Seat Safety <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The parents should use a rear-facing car seat placed in the middle back seat (ATI Nursing, 2023d).• The infant should remain in a rear-facing car seat until 2 years old or until they have reached the maximum height/weight limits (ATI Nursing, 2023d).• Education should be provided about the consequences of improper car seat use, such as death or injury (ATI Nursing, 2023d).
Subcategory: Home Safety
Topic: Family and Community Violence: Safety Planning Following Partner Violence <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The nurse should help the client develop a safety plan in cases of emergency (ATI Nursing, 2023e).• The nurse should provide the client with information on safety houses (ATI Nursing, 2023e).• The nurse should also help the client identify triggers that may cause their partner to become violent (ATI Nursing, 2023e).
Subcategory: Reporting of Incident/Event/Irregular Occurrence/Variance
Topic: Facility Protocols: Reporting a Medication Error <ul style="list-style-type: none">• When a medication error occurs, the person who identified the error should file an incident report (ATI Nursing, 2023b).• The incident is not placed into the client's record, but a description of the error and actions taken should be documented (ATI Nursing, 2023b).• The nurse manager should review the report (ATI Nursing, 2023b).
Subcategory: Standard Precautions/Transmission-Based Precautions/Surgical Asepsis
Topic: Acute Neurologic Disorders: Isolation Precautions for Bacterial Meningitis <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bacterial meningitis is an infection of the meninges and is very contagious (ATI Nursing, 2023f).• Droplet precautions should be implemented for clients with bacterial meningitis (ATI Nursing, 2023f).• Isolation should be kept for at least 24 hours after starting antibiotics (ATI Nursing, 2023f).
Subcategory: Use of Restraints/Safety Devices
Topic: Crisis and Anger Management: Use of Mechanical Restraints <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A provider prescription is required for the use of restraints (ATI Nursing, 2023e).• The restrained client should not be left alone and should be continuously monitored (ATI Nursing, 2023e).• The client should reflect behavior that promotes release from restraints (ATI Nursing, 2023e).

Main Category #2: Health Promotion and Maintenance
Subcategory: Health Promotion/Disease Prevention
Topic: Communicable Diseases: Immunization Recommendations for a 2-month-old Infant <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There are many immunizations recommended for a 2-month-old infant (ATI Nursing, 2023f).• Some immunizations include DTaP, rotavirus, HiB, and Hep B (ATI Nursing, 2023f).• Other immunizations include IPV and pneumococcal (ATI Nursing, 2023f).
Topic: Epidemiology and Communicable Diseases: Teaching a Group of Older Adults about Immunizations <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The nurse should educate older adults on the importance of immunizations to prevent diseases (ATI

Nursing, 2023c).

- One vaccine older adults are recommended to receive is the pneumococcal vaccine (ATI Nursing, 2023c).
- Other vaccines include influenza and Tdap (ATI Nursing, 2023c).

Subcategory: Lifestyle Choices

Topic: Older Adults (65 Years and Older): Assessing a Client for Social Isolation

- Older adults experience many changes and need to learn new ways to adapt (ATI Nursing, 2023a).
- One change older adults need to adjust to is their social development and finding new ways to be social to prevent isolation (ATI Nursing, 2023a).
- Many risk factors place older adults at risk for social isolation, such as decreased mobility, sensory impairments, cognitive impairments, and lack of family support (ATI Nursing, 2023a).

Main Category #3: Pharmacological and Parenteral Therapies

Subcategory: Adverse Effects/Contraindications/Side Effects/Interactions

Topic: Endocrine Disorders: Teaching About Adverse Effects of Levothyroxine

- Levothyroxine is a synthetic form of thyroid hormones and can be used to treat hypothyroidism (ATI Nursing, 2023g).
- Adverse effects include palpitation, fever, chest pain, anxiety, and weight loss (ATI Nursing, 2023g).
- Levothyroxine also increases the anticoagulant effects of warfarin, so unusual bleeding should be monitored for (ATI Nursing, 2023g).

Subcategory: Expected Actions/Outcomes

Topic: Psychosocial Issues of Infants, Children, and Adolescents: Evaluating the Effectiveness of Methylphenidate

- Methylphenidate is one of the medications used to help control symptoms of ADHD (ATI Nursing, 2023f).
- Dosing is increased until therapeutic results are reached (ATI Nursing, 2023f).
- Adverse effects such as insomnia, nervousness, and tachycardia should be monitored (ATI Nursing, 2023f).

Subcategory: Medication Administration

Topic: Diabetes Mellitus: Mixing Insulins in the Same Syringe

- Short-acting insulin should be drawn up first, then the longer-acting insulin (ATI Nursing, 2023g).
- NPH is an intermediate-acting insulin and appears cloudy (ATI Nursing, 2023g).
- Regular insulin is a short-acting insulin and should appear clear (ATI Nursing, 2023g).

Topic: Gastrointestinal Disorders: Teaching about Scopolamine

- Scopolamine is an anticholinergic used to treat and prevent motion sickness (ATI Nursing, 2023g).
- Scopolamine can be given transdermal, PO, subcutaneously, or intravenously (ATI Nursing, 2023g).
- To prevent motion sickness, the client should place a patch behind their ear four hours before traveling. Clients can also take one tablet an hour before traveling if they don't want to use a patch (ATI Nursing, 2023g).
