Rationale	Focused questions are a therapeutic communication technique because they allow the nurse to clarify a message, collect data, encourage feedback, and confirm the client's ideas and beliefs.

Rationale	Developing rapport with a client supports the establishment of a therapeutic relationship by sharing mutual feelings of acceptance while maintaining open communication and the development of trust and respect.

Rationale	Automatic comments are a nontherapeutic communication technique because the use of clichés minimize the client's importance and concerns.

Rationale	Displaying a caring attitude supports the establishment of a therapeutic relationship by conveying genuine concern and a feeling of emotional closeness, which results in the nurse's ability to achieve a greater level of communication and understanding with the client.

Rationale	Exploration is a therapeutic communication technique because it encourages the client to delve deeper into a topic or issue of concern.
