1. How does this project relate to Population/Global Health?

This is accomplished by the organizations commitment to raise awareness for this issue. The organizations goals align with global health and well-being by reaching out to help survivors. Survivors Resource Center organizes several sexual violence awareness events.

2. How were you an engaged nursing professional during this project?

3. How did you contribute to the service of the community with this project?

I contributed to the service of this community with this project through volunteering at the site in Danville. During my volunteering I cleaned heels that are going to be worn by male participants in the "Walk a mile in her

shoes” event the survivor resource center hosts. I also sorted out the shoes that needed to be repaired before this event and set them aside. I also made posters for the event intended to support the participants. I also categorized the toys meant for children to use during play therapy. I also put together information folders for new patients. These services will all help the goal of providing support to victims of sexual assault.

4. Name 3 ways this project site impacts community health?

This site impacts community health by providing a safe place to go for survivors of sexual abuse. This is extremely important for this community because it is already daunting to seek help and discuss what has happened and this organization wants to help. This site further impacts community health by providing a support person and ride to the hospital when victims want to be checked out for health concerns following an attack such as STIs and pregnancy. This site also impacts community health by providing trained and experienced councilors whose goal is to help children and adults cope with their trauma.

5. Name 1 way this project site could better serve the community and why?

This site could better serve the community by improving their visibility. I had been in this area several times and never knew this building was there. Even when I routed the address in maps, the building was blank with no sign. I think this is unfortunate and can be improved to better service the community by letting survivors know that this is a place they can go. This

6. What health risks are experienced by the population served by this project site?

The health risks experienced by the population served by this project site is sexually transmitted diseases and pregnancy. This can occur following a non-consensual sexual attack and is one of the major reasons victims seek treatment. This is something this site can provide educational resources on and help manage. Other health risks include post-traumatic stress disorder, anxiety disorder, depression, and other mental health disorders. These risks are evidenced by research and can cause harm to the victims' livelihood. This site helps with these risks through counseling.
