1. How does this project relate to Population/Global Health?

Community assessment/ Windshield Survey clinical is related to Population/ Global Health. This clinical was a detailed assessment of the Milford community, including the needs, strengths, resources, and other information. This information is necessary to plan how to use resources adequately to cover the needs of public health, urban planning, and community development.

2. How were you an engaged nursing professional during this project?

This nursing student was engaged in this project through research on HUD (Housing and Urban Development), finding that Milford does not have its own office for HUD like Watseka but is covered by the HUD office in Chicago. People needing help paying for housing must fill out the application/letter, send it to the office, and wait for an answer. One of the places for the people who need this kind of help is an apartment building in downtown Milford called Old Town. This information was acquired from the Village Hall official, Ms. Robin Rogers. This student got other information from the same person about the newspapers and homes in Milford. This student searched for Radio stations in Milford, and apparently, there are three licensed by the FCC official license in Milford, although they do not have to be precisely in Milford to get this license. They can be out of the village but must cover most of the area. Several radio stations are close to Milford, mostly in Watseka (WGF-AM) and Hoopston (WHPO-FM).

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3. How did you contribute to the service of the community with this project?

This nursing student and other nursing students contributed to the Windshield community assessment. During the activity, this nursing student assessed the community from the car and took over ninety photos of the community, some of which were later used for power points. The photos were incorporated into housing, apartment complexes, and Village Hall topics. Also, this nursing student participated in the project by acquiring information through phone calls and online research about the communication and housing topics in the Milford community.

4. Name 3 ways this project site impacts community health?

A detailed and systematic assessment of the community can diagnose health problems and direct the future development of community health. Fortunately, the Milford community already has a well-developed Public Health Department in Watseka. This department impacts Milford's health in many ways. It contains the Environmental Health Department, which protects food from foodborne diseases. It has a Portable water program that prevents diseases from spreading through water and pollution of drinking water. There is a Vector control program that fights mosquitos that are carrying the Zika virus and West Nile virus. Many education programs teach grade children basic hygiene or teach sitters to give CPR. The Community Health Department does communicable disease screening or lead screening in blood.

5. Name 1 way this project site could better serve the community and why?

This nursing student was engaged during this project in several ways. One way was visiting the Milford community and participating in the community. The most important way this project could better serve this community is to define the community's needs and plan how to use the resources in favor of health promotion and the health needs of the residents. That can be done through better health education of residents, better referrals of residents to providers that can help them, and advocacy.

6. What health risks are experienced by the population served by this project site?

Three primary health risks experienced by the Milford, IL population are cardiovascular diseases, Diabetes Mellitus, and cancer. Also, there are liver problems, chronic respiratory infections, and obesity. The most common STDs are Chlamydial infections and Gonorrhea, which are on the increase.
