

## Clinical Experience Summary

This report will be a minimum of 2 pages in APA format. Each question needs to have a minimum of one paragraph response. In-text citations should be utilized. Use your textbook, the internet, and other scholarly resources to assist with in-text citations.

1. What is the priority nursing diagnosis for your patient? Why did you choose this diagnosis? (5 points)

The priority nursing diagnosis for my patient was ‘acute pain related to uterine contractions and stretching of the cervix as evidenced by the patient rating pain 8 out of 10’ (Durham et al., 2023). I chose this nursing diagnosis because my patient was having lots of pain due to their contractions. The patient had two rounds of IV fentanyl before finally deciding to get an epidural. By the time she was getting the epidural, she was in tears from the pain.

2. Identify 3 nursing interventions supporting the nursing diagnosis? Explain what these interventions are and why they should be completed. (15 points)

One of the nursing interventions tried was repositioning the patient to relieve pain. We repositioned the patient from the supine position onto their left side to alleviate some pain. Repositioning did help for some time before needing to be repositioned again. Repositioning in labor has been shown to decrease the use of epidural and cesarean delivery rates and can shorten the first stage of labor by more than one hour (Smith et al., 2021).

Another nursing intervention for my patients' pain would be continuous labor support. The nurse, I, and the patient's husband were with the patient, giving them continuous emotional support while they went through the labor process. The nurse and I aided the patient in labor support by helping them through contractions and pain and educating them through the process. Continuous labor support has been shown to decrease rates of assisted vaginal births and cesarean delivery and the use of pain medications (Smith et al., 2021).

The last nursing intervention that we tried with the patient was pain medication. The patient was rating their pain 8 out of 10 and wanted to do the IV fentanyl. We were able to give the patient IV pain medication, which gave her some relief, but she was still rating her pain as 7 out of 10. They ended up wanting to do the epidural, which gave her the most relief. Intravenously administered fentanyl is safe and significantly reduces pain from baseline to delivery among low-risk pregnancies ( Duangkum et al., 2024). An epidural creates a band of numbness from the belly button to the top of the legs, allowing the patient to stay awake and feel the pressure of labor but without the pain (MacMillan, 2023).

3. What was the evaluation of each of the previously identified nursing interventions? (10 points)

The evaluation for these three nursing interventions would be asking patients to rate their pain after implementation, evaluating their non-verbal cues, and asking and answering the patients' questions. After giving the patient their IV fentanyl, we asked them to rate their pain on a scale of one to ten so that we could see if there was any improvement in their pain. After the patient received the epidural, we made sure to ask them how their pain was and if they were completely numb or if they still felt pressure with contractions. When repositioning the patient, we asked them if their pain was better and assessed their non-verbal communication. While providing continuous labor support to ease the pain of contractions, we educated the patient on breathing through contractions, we asked them if they wanted to get out of bed, and we answered the patient's questions about labor.

4. Describe this patient's culture and identify a minimum of 2 patient preferences relating to their culture. (10 points)

My patient's culture is scrunchy. Scrunchy culture is where you believe in holistic and more natural things while also believing in modern things. My patient had the preference of both breastfeeding and formula feeding her baby. They also preferred to try repositioning to help with pain and holding off on the epidural before the pain got too severe.

5. Reflection of clinical experience. (5 points)

- a. What was one thing that put you outside your comfort zone?

One thing that put me outside of my comfort zone would be being on the labor and delivery unit, which I had never been on, other than for my own deliveries. I just felt out of my comfort zone because I wasn't sure what to expect, how to help, or what they would let me do. It wasn't long that I felt uncomfortable because I really felt like I was able to assist the nurse and the patient with almost whatever they needed me to do.

b. In what way did you see coordination between the health care team to provide appropriate care to the patient?

I saw coordination between the healthcare team in a couple of ways. The nurse had to first reach out to the doctor in order to get the patient's diet order changed from clear liquids to regular so that they could have a normal meal before they would have to start Pitocin. Another time that communication was utilized was when the residents told the nurse they could start Pitocin. However, before the nurse started it, she had to review the fetal heart monitor, where she noted the baby was having early decelerations. The nurse then let the residents know that it would be best to wait to start the Pitocin.
