| RN Evaluation                                      | 1            | 100.0%           | The evaluation step of the nursing process involves the nurse's ability to evaluate a client's response to nursing interventions and to reach a nursing judgment regarding the extent to which the client has met the goals and outcomes. During this step the nurse will also assess client/staff understanding of instruction, the effectiveness of interventions, and identify the need for further intervention or the need to alter the plan.                        |
