It is important to provide cost effective care, which includes the use of equipment only when indicated.</p> <hr/> <p><b>Order violations - 5 selected</b></p> <p>Order violations occur when you move through the sequence of body areas in the incorrect order; move through the assessment techniques of inspection, palpation, and auscultation in the incorrect order; fail to place or remove gloves when required; or fail to provide for privacy or safety considerations before initiating or concluding a health assessment scenario.</p>
