

## Clinical Experience Summary

1. What is the priority nursing diagnosis for your patient? Why did you choose this diagnosis? **(5 points)**
  - a. Risk for injury related to loss of consciousness as evidenced by the patient having a seizure (Phelps, 2023). I chose this nursing diagnosis because the patient had a history of seizures and was no longer taking Keppra. Not taking antiseizure medications increases her chance of having a seizure while pregnant. I thought risk for injury was a good nursing diagnosis because the patient had not a seizure in over a year, but the doctor told the patient to not take their medication anymore. The nurse Kristine who was taking care of the patient said that there is not enough evidence to show if it would cause harm to the baby if the patient continued to take the medication while being pregnant. Looking through the chart, the patient was told to stop taking their medication before even getting pregnant.
2. Identify 3 nursing interventions supporting the nursing diagnosis? Explain what these interventions are and why they should be completed. **(15 points)**
  - a. Ensure all hazardous items are removed from the bedside to help prevent injury to the patient if a seizure were to happen (Phelps, 2023). Remove all objects near the bedside and the bedside table to ensure the patient won't be able to harm themselves if a seizure were to happen. If the patient experiences a seizure, they can experience involuntary movements that could result hitting objects and causing harm to themselves (Phelps, 2023).

5. Reflection of clinical experience. **(5 points)**

- a. What was one thing that put you outside your comfort zone or made you feel uncomfortable?
  - i. I first felt uncomfortable when I pulled into a room to watch my first vaginal delivery. The nurse Robin pulled in with her, so I was able to watch the delivery. Robin was one of the nurses helping the primary nurse who was caring for this patient. Shortly after walking into the room, I felt more comfortable because Robin was walking me through what she was going to do after the baby was born. Robin was helping with making the bracelets for the baby and the parents. I felt very comfortable being in there after talking with her. She was making sure I could get a full view of what was happening and see the whole way through. Another part that I felt outside my comfort zone was when the patient I was assigned to was having a seizure. At first, the dad came to get Kristine and me because she felt ready to push. We had just checked the patient about 10 minutes prior, and the patient was 9 cm. Once we got into the room, Kristine immediately called for help because the patient started to have a seizure once we entered the room. It was interesting to watch how the team worked together. I did feel uncomfortable when one of the nurses asked for an oxygen mask and looked at all of us students at the back of the room. Arian was in the room, and she left to go get. At that point, I felt very comfortable because I was unsure which supply room had the oxygen supplies. After the patient got stable and I was able to meet back up

with Kristine, I was able to talk to her about everything that had happened in the room. I was shortly asking the nurses which supply had the oxygen masks and cannulas. Now I feel more comfortable getting the necessary supplies that are needed when asked.

- b. In what way did you see coordination among the health care team (any discipline) to provide appropriate care to the patient?
  - i. I was not sure what all I was going to be able to do at clinical since it was my first day on the unit. After I got the report with Kristine on our patient, we sat down at the computer, and she talked me through what she was doing and showed me the monitor and what the contractions looked like and how often they were happening. Kristine let me help reposition the patient to help the baby move, and she showed me different positions we could use to help progress the baby's movement, along with positions that help with the baby's positioning. Kristine showed me how to change the bags for the epidural. I was able to give the patient and the dad some ice water throughout the morning. I was able to start another syringe of ampicillin connected to the IV pump with the help of Kristine.
