Nursing Diagnosis/Outcomes

- 1) Impaired Skin Integrity RT Imobility → New Pressure Ulcer develops @ foley site
- 2) Risk for bleeding → bleeding from PICC line site → reapphpal
- 3) Risk for infection → NO S/S infection.
- 4) Activity intolerance → Pt remained activity intolerated.

73 yr. Female Caucasian.  
w/ ch. A fib. Myasthenia gravis.  
Breast Cancer. Diabetes.  
Diverticular. HTN.  
Ch. Resp. Insufficiency

Nursing Interventions

- ↑ fluid, Nutrition (TPN)
- Turn q 2h.
- Minimize needle insertion
- Press 5-10 mm Hg in case needle insertion (cannot avoid)
- Monitor Lab: PTT INR.
- Monitor V/s: Temp, HR, BP, O<sub>2</sub>.
- Report S/S of infection.
- Admi. passive ROM.
- ↑ O<sub>2</sub> ZL/NC.
