Don't Call Me Crazy: Episode 1- Beth and Emma

Objective: The goal of the activity is to observe the clients/peers and clients/staff interactions and relationships while on the Psychiatric Unit and how mental illness impacts their lives.

1. What is the difference between a documentary and reality TV? _____ **(1 point)**
A documentary is a non-fiction film that re-enacts a time in history. On the other hand, a reality TV show does not have to be entirely factual, with the focus being on the dramatic story line. In essence, a reality TV show is a fictional story but uses historical events in the context (Layton, 2006).

2. Describe the main characters: Beth and Emma _____ **(5 points)**

Beth is a 17-year-old female who has an eating disorder and is experiencing depression along with suicidal thoughts. These two reasons are why she has been admitted to the unit. Her eating issues started when she was 9 years old. She has intense anxiety and severe distress when she is faced with having to consume calories. She refuses efforts made by the staff and is not handling treatment efforts well.

Emma is a 15-year-old female who is diagnosed with obsessive compulsive disorder (OCD). Her OCD has started to make her depressed and suicidal. She has intrusive thoughts in her mind that take over and interfere with her life. She experiences frequent anxiety and has panic attacks. She didn't like when the staff searched through her room and reorganized her things. She has a good relationship with her family.

3. Identify two (2) priority client problems for Beth. _____ **(2 points)**

1. Beth views herself as fat or overweight.

2. She is not complying with her treatment regimen. For example, she is hiding a meal supplement that makes her feel full so she doesn't have to consume as much food. She also refuses to get weighed or have her blood drawn for labs.
