

## N433 – Active Learning for School Nurse Shadowing Experience

Complete this Active Learning activity after your clinical with the School Nurse. You must receive 77% in order to pass this clinical assignment.

1. How does this clinical site relate to the course?

The clinical site is an upper elementary school; I had the opportunity to observe how they administer medications to kids ages 5<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> grade and what their health issues are at this age.

2. How were you an engaged nursing professional today?

I was an engaged nursing professional showing interest, asking questions and engaging in pediatric nursing procedures in this facility

3. How did you contribute to the service provided by the school nurse today?

I assisted in watching kids in classrooms while the nurse spoke to some teachers; I also assisted in assessments and observing medication administration

4. Name **3** ways this clinical site impacts Pediatric health?

First, they make sure that every kid meets their medication needs in a timely matter.  
Second, they are available during school hours in case some of the students get sick or hurt.

Third, they keep track of medical history and immunization records

5. What are the health risks of the population served during today's clinical based on your observations today?

The students at higher risk based on my observations are those who are diabetics since they are always at risk of being hypoglycemic or having complications.

Other common problems among this population are ADHD, anxiety, asthma, sport injuries, upper respiratory infections and GI upsets.

6. Choose one of the health risks identified in question 5 and develop a plan of care to address this. Include a Nursing diagnosis, a measurable goal, and at least 3 Nursing interventions to achieve this goal.

Nursing Diagnosis: Risk for Unstable Blood Glucose related to Lack of adherence to diabetes management as evidenced by fluctuating blood sugar values

Measurable goal: Kids with diabetes would maintain a target blood glucose below 140 during school hours

Nursing Interventions (3):

1.-Control carbohydrate intake with each meal at school

2.-Scheduled insulin and sliding scale will be administered during school hours

3.-Educate kids about healthy snacks and meal options

Goal: Kids with a diagnosis of diabetes will be able to keep their blood sugar readings on their target goals by controlling carbs, healthy eating choices and timely insulin administration during their school day.

7. How will your experience during the School Nurse job shadowing impact your Nursing practice?

Now I have a clear idea of what a school nurse job does. I am aware of how medications are administered at a school environment and how to do focus health assessments if needed for any health concerns that may arise. This increased my previous knowledge in pediatric nursing and will help in my future practice.
