

Safety & Infection Control

- Safety is always the #1 priority when caring for a distressed patient.
- When a client is in restraints, a nurse must perform neurosensory assessments every 2 hours. They are checking for mobility, sensation, and circulation.
- Restraints are never a PRN order.
- The doctor must examine the client before allowing restraints.
- In the case of a fire, always move the patient away from the area before you do anything else.
- Bioterrorism = airborne precautions.
- During a disaster, a nurse must ensure that there is plenty of PPE for workers to protect themselves.
- Airborne precautions = N95 mask, negative air pressure room, mask (clients should wear one when leaving their room).
- General measures to prevent falls = ensure that the client knows how to use his/her assistive device, maintain the bed in a low position, adequate lighting, non-slip socks, lock wheels on the bed, chairs, or carts, and use chair or bed sensors.

Management of Care:

- Interpersonal conflict is any differing values or beliefs between two people.
- Intrapersonal conflict is an internal struggle that creates contradictory values.
- If a client refuses treatment or leaves the facility without a prescription discharge, a nurse must go over the potential risks and ask the client to sign an AMA paper. The nurse must then document.
- If a client is unclear about a procedure after they signed the informed consent, a nurse must notify the physician.
- Nurses must continuously set and reset priorities to assess all client's needs while maintaining safety.
- Nurses must delegate appropriately and supervise adequately to ensure client safety while utilizing effective time management.
