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The first group meeting which was about case management **was not interesting**, it gives me insight as to how things work which I am grateful for. Case management basically was about what a client would do when they get discharged from the hospital. I felt **it was a lot of information about the client and their personal life shared with other clients**. I would not feel **uncomfortable with that sharing if I was participating, I think it is too large of a group setting**.

Honestly it was nothing like our professor showed us. It was quite bland, in better terms. The colors were very muted, there was good lighting but it was artificial. I don't think it's the best environment, personally, if I would be in there. **I found that the environment was a tad boring**. Nurses did not have much for us to do. We were either standing, reading charts, watching TV, or conversing with clients. I honestly do wish they would've let us take vitals or participate in groups to a certain extent. I would enjoy a bit more structure because that is just the type of person I am.
