  - History – Acts
  - Letters/Epistles Paulistic – Paul's Letters
  - General Letters/Epistles – Letters not written by Paul
  - Apocalyptic Literature
2. What is the only book of history in the New Testament (though other books contain historical information)?
  - Acts
3. What are referred to as the "General Epistles"?
  - Letters not written by Paul
4. What were probably the first epistles written by Paul?
  - Galatians, 1 & 2 Thessalonians

  - 8-9

  - Paul
8. Which authors wrote most of the New Testament and what percent of the New Testament did they write?
  - Luke, Paul, & John
  - 70%
9. How many years separate the Old Testament and New Testament?
  - Nearly 430 years
10. What nations that make up the intertestamental period were prophesied in Nebuchadnezzar's dream?
  - Babylonian Empire, Persian Empire, Greek Empire, & Roman Empire

11. What does Galatians 4 remind us of?
