*The Gospel of Mark*

1. Its too short or abbreviated
2. Jesus is the Beloved Son
3. At His death
4. Jesus's whole ministry and death is a part of His identity. The Son of God isn't a title, its His identity.
5. By saying He is the Son of God, according to Psalms, this means He is the King of Israel and the world. He is Blessed One
