The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. This meeting is also intended to determine whether changes are needed to the service plan based on the assessment information, the license holder's evaluation of progress towards accomplishing outcomes, or other information provided by the team.

**A Review of Technology needs for the individual served:** *Wayne has no unmet technology needs at this time. Wayne has glasses he wears daily. Wayne uses a CPAP at night due to his sleep apnea with staff assistance. Wayne uses his tablet to Zoom with his family most weeks with staff assistance and occasionally watch videos on it.*

**A review of the person's service and support outcomes occurred and the following determinations regarding those outcomes were made:**

*Wayne would like to continue to send letters to his mother and sister weekly. He has not been doing this weekly and will need more staff reminders. Wayne repeated that he likes to send and receive mail.*

**Discussion regarding person-centered program planning:**

What are the opportunities to develop and maintain **essential and life-enriching skills, abilities, strengths, interests, and preferences**?

*Wayne is offered activities he enjoys while at home and staff facilitate such as starting the outside of the puzzles. Wayne prides himself with helping at home by checking the mail, answering the phone, and taking out the garbage at his home. Wayne enjoys writing letters and sending cards to family as holidays come around. Wayne is always interested in outings with housemates, peers, and families.*

What are the opportunities **for community access, participation, and inclusion** in preferred community activities?

*Wayne and his housemates have outings most weekends when the weather cooperates. Wayne enjoys attending local sporting events and community activities with his housemates. Wayne is always eager to participate in group activities facilitated by MCGH or the ODC.*

What are the opportunities to **develop and strengthen personal relationships** with other persons of the person's choice in the community?

*Wayne spends time with peers at the ODC daily. Wayne has opportunity to see additional peers at MCGH group activities. Wayne enjoys seeing many members of the community while going out to local community activities and sporting events. Wayne enjoys his time when he gets to go home to stay with his mom and spend time with his sister.*

What are the opportunities to seek **competitive employment** and work at competitively paying jobs in the community?

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*Due to Wayne's cognitive disability, Wayne is not a candidate for competitive employment at this time.*

## **Other meeting discussion notes:**

**Home:** Wayne had broken his DVD/VCR player when he accidentally knocked it off his cabinet. His sister had a replacement for him to use. His mom and sister are working on getting an addition built onto his cabinet that would allow for more space for him to have his DVD/VCR and TV on this cabinet. It was also brought up that when Wayne rearranges his movies in this cabinet, he has pushed the back off the cabinet and the movies have spilled out. He may need to replace this cabinet in the future. Wayne regularly has zoom meetings with his mom and sister on the weekends. When the regular weekend staff have been working, the zoom meetings have gone well.

With Easter around the corner, Wayne is talking about wanting to get to Holy Thursday mass. Wayne continues to enjoy going to church and the team talked about getting Wayne to all the church services that were important to him. Occasionally, he has been unable to go when all his housemates are not on board with going. Additional staff has been scheduled when available to make sure Wayne can go to church. Wayne went to most of the home basketball games this winter with his housemates. He has been regularly going to the library as well as other community outings and group activities.

Wayne did have couple instances when staff needed to intervene. Once, he took a candy bar at a store without paying. He did allow staff to put it back. Another time, he had eaten an entire package of breakfast sausage that the staff had pre-cooked for the next day's breakfast.

**Medical:** Since Wayne's last team meeting, he had been to the dentist to get a filling taken care of and had been to the dentist for his semiannual check up again in February. Wayne had a quarterly Whitney Sleep appointment. At this appointment, his memory card showed that usage had increased to 80% of nights over the last 3 months. The data card also showed some obstruction, so his pressure was increased. He was due for a new machine so he will have one he can use at his mom's and one he can keep at home. Provider would like a follow up again in 6 months with Whitney sleep. This appt is scheduled for 4-24-24.

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Wayne has lost some weight since his last meeting. Over the last year, he has lost 16 pounds. The staff have been working on healthy portion sizes. This may have been what has led to Wayne's weight loss. Wayne still seems to have a good appetite.

**ODC:** Wayne spends his time at the ODC reading and writing his letters weekly to the people on his address list. Lacey states they have been rotating through his list of addresses to send to people. Wayne enjoys going to the post office himself to mail his letters and cards.
