Jason has made a variety of meals. He has made spaghetti, tacos, sloppy joes, a breakfast meal and even a pistachio dessert. A couple of those items were new for Jason to make with staff. A few times Jason cancelled due to other activities or illness. Plan to continue with current outcome, introducing new meals as Jason allows so he can expand his skills.

School: Jason is in his junior year at Warren Alvarado High School. He is currently in the middle of his track season. He is not able to work at the school this summer as he did last year since there is a large construction project starting. He plans to mow lawns with his dad this summer to make some money. At this time, Jason says he is not going to prom but he plans to go to the after prom party.

In Home: Jason has been meeting with staff on average twice monthly. There were a few times that Jason had to cancel due to illness or family things that were planned. Jason reports that he is good with how many times each month he is currently meeting with staff. Staff plans to continue to meet with him twice monthly through the summer. During their contact times, staff pick him up, and he usually has a recipe picked out and list of what he needs. He's been going to the store and will shop for good prices unless there is a brand of something he prefers. Then he can make the recipe with some help understanding the instructions and occasionally some measurements. It was discussed whether Jason would like to attend horse therapy but he said he was not interested at this time.

In the past, Jason has enjoy participating in some of the activities that MCGH does as a group, such as the races. Staff will plan to do this outing again this summer. The summer picnic is also scheduled for June 13.

Jason's annual meeting is scheduled for Oct 10, 2024 at 1p to take place at MCSS.
