The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. This meeting is also intended to determine whether changes are needed to the service plan based on the assessment information, the license holder's evaluation of progress towards accomplishing outcomes, or other information provided by the team.

A Review of Technology needs for the individual served: *Kevin wears prescription eyeglasses, has a medication dispensing machine installed in his home and a cell phone.*

A review of the person's service and support outcomes occurred and the following determinations regarding those outcomes were made:

Kevin's goal to learn to cook and/or bake will continue as written.

Kevin's goal to participate in community outings monthly will continue as written.

Changes needed to the Support Plan Addendum, Self-Management Assessment, or other document in the service plan, include, if any: *No changes were made to Kevin's plans during this meeting.*

Other meeting discussion notes:

Health: *Please see the attached Physician Order Log for a list of Kevin's medical appointments and a list of his current medications. Kevin had an appt that was not listed on the log; it was on 4/11/24 with Dr. Cory Edwards, Altru Neurologist. Dr. Edwards note was to increase the Primidone 50mg ((1 tab) AM and 100mg (2 tabs) PM for 2 weeks then 2 tabs (100mg) twice daily. Cindy is to contact Dr. Joseph's office to ask if the referral with Susan Thompson, Neuropsych was made. Kevin is drinking instant decaf coffee and gave away all of his caffeinated coffee. Katie encouraged him to drink Propel or Powerade instead of energy drinks. Kevin hesitantly agreed to cut back to having 1 energy drink/day.*

IHS Outcomes: *Kevin still has not been able to work on his cooking/baking outcome very much. MaryKay will now be working with him an additional day each week and they will focus on the cooking and tasks within his home.*

IHS Outings: *Kevin participated in the following outings this quarterly review period – Out to eat several times, the Shrine Circus and the Monster Trucks.*

ODC: *Kevin stated he is working two days/week (Wed, Thurs) at DigiKey currently. He also cleans the bathrooms at the ODC on those days. Bert Foster is the Employment Specialist with the ODC. Steven Roper is the ODC Job Coach that supervises at DigiKey. Bert stated that Kevin's work performance has improved and Kevin is "more alert and focused."*

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Other: Kevin no longer wants MOM's Meals – Katie will discontinue this service. Kevin got a cat on 3/9/24 – her name is Dorothy. He is doing well with taking care of her and keeping her litter box clean. Kevin proudly showed everyone a picture of his cat. He has a new housekeeper starting. His last haircut was on 3/11/24 in Karlstad; he agreed to go to Styles by Amy in Thief River Falls from now on.
