The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. This meeting is also intended to determine whether changes are needed to the service plan based on the assessment information, the license holder's evaluation of progress towards accomplishing outcomes, or other information provided by the team.

### **A Review of Technology needs for the individual served:**

*Vinette has custom fit orthotics for her shoes that she is to wear at all times.*

### **A review of the person's service and support outcomes occurred and the following determinations regarding those outcomes were made:**

- 1. Vinette will attend church services or watch church on television (when there is inclement weather) two times per month. Outcome to continue as written.*
- 2. Vinette will put her lunch items into her lunchbox to take to the ODC Monday-Friday. Outcome to continue as written.*

**Changes needed to the Coordinated Service and Support Plan Addendum, Self-Management Assessment, or other document in the service plan, include, if any:** *SP Addendum: Scope of Services: added that Vinette is to be escorted at all times when she is outside the home due to her poor balance and not paying attention to where she is walking. List of providers was updated to include Cayla Worner, Hennepin County Case Manager. Psychotropic Medication Monitoring – target symptoms the medication is to alleviate were added to Vinette's SP Addendum. List of attendees and date of annual meeting was updated on the SP, IAPP and SMA.*

### **Discussion regarding person-centered program planning:**

What are the opportunities to develop and maintain **essential and life-enriching skills, abilities, strengths, interests, and preferences**? *Vinette attends the ODC, Inc. Monday-Friday which is a day program. However, this program is decreasing their hours of operation to Monday – Thursday, starting the week of 4/22/24. She likes to go to church on Sundays and has attended several Sundays in the past couple of months.*

What are the opportunities **for community access, participation, and inclusion** in preferred community activities? *Vinette participates in outings such as going to church, attending the circus, going out to eat, bowling, attending local community events – Marshall County Fair, community theater plays, free music at the park during the summer.*

What are the opportunities to **develop and strengthen personal relationships** with other persons of the person's choice in the community? *Vinette has a "visiting friend" Becky Adrian that takes Vinette to her home one time/week and visits with her for an hour. She has a family in Roseau, MN that invites her to spend Christmas with them. She attends church services almost weekly. Vinette loves to be around people and will agree to social events offered to her. She also shows compassion for her housemates and will spend time with them.*

What are the opportunities to seek **competitive employment** and work at competitively paying jobs in the community? *Vinette denies any interest in competitive employment.*

Other meeting discussion notes:

Health: *Vinette's Nursing Summary was presented by Henrietta Linder, Residential RN. A copy of her Individual Care Plan was provided to the team. (See attached). Vinette is in good general health and has had very few medical appts in the past six months. Vinette is using the lift on the Tri-Valley Bus as she was having difficulty walking up the steps into the bus. She is to be escorted by staff to and from the bus due to uneven concrete and Vinette's poor balance. Vinette will have her annual physical in July, 2024; Henrietta will send a message in MyChart asking Jill Smith, NP to order a lipid panel prior to her annual physical.*

*Vinette needs to be evaluated for new shoe inserts as the last pair she purchased was in 2021. Cindy will send Jill Smith a message, via MyChart, to ask for a referral to Altru Orthotics (where Vinette had them made previously). Carly Worner, Case Manager stated that Vinette's waiver will cover any costs that are not covered by Vinette's insurance.*

ODC Report/Goals: *Reviewed by Lacey Bayne. Vinette is spending her time painting, and writing, looking at books. She enjoys participating in activities, with staff assistance. .*

*Vinette's visiting friend, Becky Adrian has been visiting Vinette one time per week most weeks. She is taking Vinette to her home for a cup of coffee and an activity. Vinette looks forward to her visits with Becky.*

Residential – *Vinette is doing well residing on Cedar South. Staff have been working on Vinette's cuticles and fingernails by soaking them and applying tea tree oil. Her nail beds looks great and she is looking forward to having her nails polished.*
