

Corrie Penn DAC Intake Meeting Minutes  
5/30/24

Cindy to email copies of Corrie's IAPP, ISMA, SP Addendum, Annual Health Care Plan, a PCP signed Medication list and a PCP signed Standing Orders List.

Corrie is to bring his own lunch with a cold pack as there is not refrigerator space. The DAC staff will heat his lunch, if needed. He is also to pack a snack for 10:30a break time. There is no afternoon snack time but the DAC will give him his 2p Ensure with ice cream (we will need to provide the ice cream). The DAC provides clothing protectors so Cedar South does not need to send any. The DAC and Cedar South will use a Communication Log Book. The DAC will write a little note on how Corrie's day went, if they need wipes/briefs or liners, if he needs more spending money for outings.

Cedar South is to send an extra outfit for Corrie to keep at the DAC. CS will send \$30 cash for outings; the DAC will let CS know when they need more money. The balance at the DAC will not exceed \$30. A ledger and copies of the receipts will be sent to CS.

Discussed Corrie start with attending the DAC 3 days/week (M,W,F) and working his way into 5 days/week. Tentatively, the Tri-Valley Bus will pick up individuals in Argyle by 8a. They will be transported to River Place where they will then transfer into a DAC bus and drive to East Grand Forks. At the end of the day, they will leave the DAC at 2:40p to return to River Place. CN/CS staff will meet the bus and transfer individuals into a MCGH vehicle to be transported back to Argyle. Corrie will be starting at the DAC on Monday, 6/17/24.

Corrie and staff were then given a tour of the DAC. Several individuals already knew Corrie as he attended this DAC several years ago. Corrie appeared a little overwhelmed with everyone talking to him as evidenced of being quiet and having a concerned look on his face. He did say "hi" several times and gave out a couple of loud noises.

The DAC has a facebook page if staff would like to see posts from outings/activities/events. It is PolkCountyDAC – the posts include the Crookston and East Grand Forks DAC's.
