Other meeting discussion notes:

Medical: Amanda continues to not have a cord for her medication machine. She tells the team she is taking the medication as prescribed. Her IHS staff checks with her weekly that her medication machine is filled. Amanda says she plans to get cords for her and her son's machines.

Housing/Family: Amanda no longer has her friend living with her as she has found a place of her own. However, there is a significant odor left in the home and especially in the room that the friend's dogs were housed in. Amanda has had the carpets cleaned professionally and has tried to clean that third bedroom but the odor persists.

Since her friend had used the futon mattress (without sheets) that her son had previously used, it would be ideal to get him a new bed. Currently Amanda has a full mattress on a queen frame. She would like a queen mattress to go with it and her son would need a full frame. Amanda currently has the funds to cover this. But these may need to be purchase one at a time to limit the effect on her savings account. Amanda intends to throw out the futon mattress.

Amanda continues to be in a relationship with her boyfriend. At times, this has put a strain on her relationship with her son. At this meeting, her son asked for more communication when she is not going to be home by the time she had previously planned on.

Her friend has still asked her and/or her son to babysit for her and it was discussed that Amanda should be the one to watch the kids when they agree to babysit so that her son isn't put in a stressful situation. Recently, her son had helped out and he was quite worked up by the end of the session.

Work: Amanda states she is generally happy with her job. Recently there have been some management and staff changeover and that has been something she has had to get used to. Amanda is now working M-Th. According to the paystubs she turned in, she is still within what she can make without losing her disability status. She says she gets along well with the new site supervisor. She did not like it when there was tension at work with other staff and the supervisor and she felt she was put in the middle. She said she had taken half a day off last week as a mental health day.

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MCGH: Amanda is able to meet with staff 1-2x weekly. It has often been hard to coordinate schedules to meet with Amanda with her new work schedule. Staff meet with her after work, and she is not always eager to work on some things at home after a day of work or she has plans with people in her life soon after work. Her laundry has been difficult to maintain. IHS worker suggested making a couple trips to the laundromat to get caught up. The team discussed Amanda assigning a couple small items for her son to complete to help with the home while she is at work. Amanda would send reminder texts to get items done. Amanda would like to keep working on goals as is. The team discussed the importance of cleaning out her storage unit so that she could save the money she is spending on those units monthly.

Action items:

- Get new cords for med machines
- New full frame for son
- New queen mattress for Amanda
