## SERVICE PLAN REVIEW MEETING AND ATTENDANCE NOTES

Type of service plan review meeting (i.e. annual): **Semi-Annual**

Location of meeting: *Cedar North*

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. This meeting is also intended to determine whether changes are needed to the service plan based on the assessment information, the license holder's evaluation of progress towards accomplishing outcomes, or other information provided by the team.

**A Review of Technology needs for the individual served:** *Hailey has an iPad she enjoys using for her own entertainment. She has no additional technology needs at this time. Hailey has stated she would enjoy having her own phone but her parents do not feel she is ready for that step at this time.*

**A review of the person's service and support outcomes occurred and the following determinations regarding those outcomes were made:** *Hailey does not initiate this outcome of choosing leisure activity to participate in with housemates and/or staff. One thing she has been doing, of her choice, is creating iPhones from paper, tape, markers and pipe cleaners. She enjoys making them almost daily.*

**Changes needed to the Support Plan Addendum, Self-Management Assessment, or other document in the service plan, include, if any:** *No changes were made to Hailey's plans during her Semi-Annual meeting.*

### **Discussion regarding person-centered program planning:**

What are the opportunities to develop and maintain **essential and life-enriching skills, abilities, strengths, interests, and preferences**? *Hailey continues to attend her local high school, Warren/Alvarado/Oslo, for another school year. Together with her parents, she will choose what classes she wants to enroll in. She will be encouraged to participate in and assist in planning activities she enjoys when she is living at Cedar North – drawing, church, shopping, baking, crafts, meal prep, being read to and learning board/yard games.*

What are the opportunities for **community access, participation, and inclusion** in preferred community activities? *Hailey participates in horse therapy 1x/week during the summer/fall months; she likes to participate in Park River Bible Camp; enjoys shopping. Staff will assist Hailey in participating in activities of her choice.*

What are the opportunities to **develop and strengthen personal relationships** with other persons of the person's choice in the community? *Hailey will be invited to all Marshall County Group Home events: annual picnic, fall party/dance, etc. She also spends time with her family members. Hailey has some friends at her high school and church.*

What are the opportunities to seek **competitive employment** and work at competitively paying jobs in the community? *Hailey and her parents would like her to have placement at the ODC or with VocRehab services to pursue community employment. Hailey's mother stated that there will be a meeting in August, 2024 with Voc Rehab Services and that the plan is for Hailey to attend school part of the day and then attend the ODC the other part of the day.*

**Other meeting discussion notes:**

**Health:** *See the attached report prepared by Henrietta Linder, Residential RN. Hailey's parents report that Hailey is receiving counseling at the CVIC. Her parents transport her to most of these appointments and will ask CN staff to transport if they are unable to. Hailey's generic Adderall is to be ordered at the Warren Pharmacy; a new prescription is required each time the medication is filled. Henrietta will contact the pharmacy to see if they obtain the renewal or if she will be sending a message in AltruMyChart to Dr. Asogwa to renew the prescription – Henrietta will confirm this plan with Hailey's parents. Hailey's dad stated that he completed the paperwork at Social Services for Hailey to have Medicare Part B. He stated her other medications are to be sent to HomeFree and if there is a cost he will pay for them out of pocket.*

**Concerns:** *Hailey's parents shared that the trial dates have been set for Hailey's Vulnerable Adult Sexual Abuse case. It will be August 22- 23, 2024.*

**Daily:** *Every Saturday, staff encourage Hailey to organize her closet and clean her bedroom when she is home on the weekends. Hailey has been walking to the end of the group home driveway and back a few times during the day and taking a break from her Ipad and making paper iPhones. She will be going to the Marshall County Fair on Saturday with group home staff. Parents are giving her spending money for the fair that is not a part of her petty cash. Hailey is excited to ride on the rides.*

**Misc:** *Hailey's parents plan to send her to school until the Winter break before her 22<sup>nd</sup> birthday and then she will not return to school after the holidays that year. When eating out, Hailey is to have an entrée and a drink. She has been ordering an appetizer too and that is too much for her to eat and expensive.*

**Annual Meeting:** *January 17, 2025 at 2:00p at the Marshall County Courthouse. Carol will pick her up from school that day to bring her to the meeting.*

## HAILEY KLEVEN SEMI-ANNUAL 7/17/24

Hailey's annual meeting was held on 2/8/24. Hailey's appetite is generally good. Her weight a year ago on 6/29/23 was 166.1lbs; on 1/2/24 was 156.8lbs and weight on 6/19/24 was 155.4lbs. On days when Hailey does not like what is being served for a meal, she will often prepare an alternative for herself. Hailey loves pizza Friday's.

On 2/14/24 Hailey c/o a headache after school and was given Tylenol with relief obtained.

On 2/29/24 Hailey was seen by Dr. Susan Zewlewski. She ordered a Fluticasone steroid inhaler 1 puff daily to be used with a spacer. After use she is to brush her teeth and rinse her mouth to prevent an oral yeast infection. She also ordered Debrox ear drops 5 drops to each ear 2 x daily on the 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup> of each month to prevent wax buildup. It was reported to her that Hailey had been doing a lot of blinking of her eyes, especially the right eye. She recommended staff continue to monitor and has an upcoming appointment for an eye exam.

On 3/18/24 Hailey had a temp of 100.4 and was picked up at school and brought home due to c/o not feeling well. She was given Tylenol. By evening she was feeling better with temp in normal range and ate a good meal. She did attend school the following day.

On 3/21/24 the facility got a call from the school stating Hailey was limping on her right leg stating it hurt. She was given Tylenol with relief.

On 3/22/24 Hailey talked to staff regarding concerns about her sister and another classmate being loud at school. Again on 4/7/24 she was concerned when her sister was going home as she could hear her screaming from the other facility connected to the facility Hailey resides at.

On 4/9/24 the school called stating Hailey had a low grade elevated temp and coughing. Once she returned to the facility her temp was 99.1 with occasional cough noted. On the morning of 4/10/24 she was afebrile but still had an occasional dry cough and small red blotches were noted on her chest. She refused staff to apply any ointment on her chest but was given Tylenol and was sent to school. That evening she coughed a lot and had a runny nose – she was given PRN Theraflu. She was kept home from school the following day due to continued low grade elevated temp with cough and cold sx. She was again given Theraflu. There was no coughing noted during the following night and on 4/12/24 she was sent to school.

On 4/17/24 Haily had an appointment with Dr. Julie Lagodinski for her eyes. Hailey was started on Refresh drops to both eyes 2 to 4 x daily and on Olopatadine drops to eyes daily. New glasses were ordered and she received them on 5/8/24.

On 4/24/24 staff received a message from the school that Haily stated it burns when she urinates and that her peri area was itchy. The following day she denied any pain in peri area. On 7/15/24 she c/o being sore in her peri area. Staff applied A&D ointment. Hailey began her menses on 7/15/24.

On 5/9/24 Hailey brought her bedding to staff stating she had an emesis during the night. Her temp was normal and she wanted to go to school so was sent.

On 5/11/24 Hailey became very agitated as she could hear her sister yelling and throwing things at adjacent facility. On 6/3/24 Hailey refused to come out of her room as she could hear her sister yelling next door. On 7/7/24 after returning from a home visit, staff noted a bruise on her left bicep area stating it happened when her sister pinched her over the weekend.

Hailey is presently attending horse therapy 1 x weekly which will continue thru the summer months. On 5/15/24 staff were informed that Hailey would begin play therapy at the Community Violence Intervention Center 2 x weekly every Tuesday and Thursday per parents request following a vulnerable adult case in which Hailey was a reported victim.

On 6/15/24 staff took Hailey to the movie theatre and while paying for the ticket Hailey was nowhere to be seen. Hailey was found to be sitting in the theatre but in the wrong movie room. Staff need to keep Hailey within visual contact at all times when on an outing.
