The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. This meeting is also intended to determine whether changes are needed to the service plan based on the assessment information, the license holder's evaluation of progress towards accomplishing outcomes, or other information provided by the team.

**A Review of Technology needs for the individual served:** *Robert wears prescription eyeglasses, leg wraps, a right ankle brace and a life alert necklace.*

**A review of the person's service and support outcomes occurred and the following determinations regarding those outcomes were made:** *Robert's outcomes/goals were reviewed. Following a discussion with Robert and his team it was decided to continue with his current outcomes as written. He has not done much in doing leisure activities in his home but a male friend of his has stated they would like to play some board games at each other's home. Staff will encourage Robert to contact his peer to play a board game.*

**Changes needed to the Coordinated Service and Support Plan Addendum, Self-Management Assessment, or other document in the service plan, include, if any:** *IAPP: Additional information was added to the Financial Exploitation section that a Monthly Petty Cash Ledger is utilized by IHS Staff for tracking Robert's spending money. SMA: Medical – Robert wears an ankle brace on the ankle he broke and leg wraps on both legs. He wears a GPS life alert necklace when he is in the community. SP Addendum: List of Service Providers was updated*

### **Discussion regarding person-centered program planning:**

What are the opportunities to develop and maintain **essential and life-enriching skills, abilities, strengths, interests, and preferences**? *Robert chooses to attend the ODC, Inc. in Warren, MN; he enjoys visiting at several local businesses in Argyle on a daily basis; he has friends he likes to cook meals with and spend time with visiting. Robert lives in a rented home independently.*

What are the opportunities **for community access, participation, and inclusion** in preferred community activities? *Robert is in the IHS Program which provides him services promoting socialization, leisure activities of his choice and inclusion in community activities.*

What are the opportunities to **develop and strengthen personal relationships** with other persons of the person's choice in the community? *Robert is very active in his community, he is a member of the Argyle Lions Club, he is an active member of Our Saviors Lutheran Church in Argyle, he participates in most community events and outings that are provided by the Individualized Home Supports (IHS) Program such as Park River Bible Day Camp, bowling, music in the park, going out to eat.*

What are the opportunities to seek **competitive employment** and work at competitively paying jobs in the community? *Robert currently attends the ODC, Inc. in Warren, MN. He has the choice to seek competitive employment if he chooses to do so through ODC services.*

Other meeting discussion notes:

**Health:** *Robert's health and medical appointments for the past year were reviewed as well as his current medications (see attached Appointment and Results List). He is currently receiving 5 Home Delivered Meals/week. Dr. Tsibulsky prescribed Robert Trazadone for sleep at his last appt. Marlene stated she feels Robert should be using a CPAP at night. Liz stated he did have a sleep study previously but would not wear the mask. Liz will ask Jeremy Houser, PA if another sleep study would be beneficial. Also, questionable if he has some neuropathy.*

**IHS Program:** *Robert has participated in several outings with IHS Program – bowling, out to eat, spending time with friends in Warren, attending county parades, and Christmas Party. Liz reported that Robert has done well when sorting through his clothes and getting rid of items he no longer wears.*

**IHS Outcomes:** *Person-centered outcomes were discussed with Robert during the meeting. He stated he would like to continue with his cooking outcome and work on learning/developing more leisure interests he can do at home.*

**ODC:** *Robert is attending the ODC four days/week (Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs). He is transported through Tri-Valley Transportation. Mary Beth Gibson, Program Specialist reviewed Robert's Person-Centered Worksheet: Wants- to save money for outings; to buy an ABBA CD. What is important to him: his work, his sister, Liz IHS Staff, Sheran Cousin, and his cat Princess. His goals at the ODC are to exercise, eat healthier and make good choices. He stated he needs Liz to be successful, wants to win when he plays a game and he likes to be told he is doing a good job. In the community he wants to work, go to church and go out to eat with his friend (EJ).*

**Family:** *Robert's sister and cousin will be taking Robert to the Marshall County Fair this weekend.*

**Next Meeting:** *The IDT agreed to meet annually. A date and time to be determined in July, 2025*
