Other meeting discussion notes:

Medical: Amanda continues to not have a cord for her medication machine. She tells the team she is taking the medication as prescribed. Her IHS staff checks with her weekly that her medication machine is filled. Amanda says she plans to get cords for her and her son's machines. Amanda has started a medication for depression.

Family: Amanda states that her and her family have good days and bad days. Her good days are days that her and her son don't argue and she enjoys when she is able to spend time with her boyfriend. Lately, she has been feeling like she is pulled between her boyfriend and her son. The team discussed some suggestions for better communication with her son so he would be less worried about when she is coming home again.

Work: Amanda states she is generally happy with her job. Following the change in management, things have settled down and she is enjoying her job.

MCGH: Amanda is struggling to stay on top of the clutter and basic cleaning in her home. When staff work with her, they spend the majority of time picking up and tidying house and occasionally are able to get to dishes and other cleaning tasks. It was suggested by staff that Amanda and Polo start picking up daily and pick up their main living area before staff arrive so that staff can then assist with the bigger tasks when they arrive. Amanda seemed to agree with this and her and her son discussed setting a reminder to pick up for 15 min daily. There have been days when food was rotting in grocery bags on the kitchen floor because it hadn't been put away when they returned home. Amanda's household has gotten behind on laundry. The team discussed getting caught up with her son's help at the local laundromat. Amanda works 4 days a week and is only able to stay on task for up to two hours after a work day. When she is not working, she is generally spending time with her boyfriend or talking to him on the phone. Amanda has not had time with staff to address cleaning out her storage unit. The litter box for the cat has been an issue and they plan to buy a litter scoop from dollar general and take turns cleaning out the litter box.

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Action items:

- Get new cords for med machines
- Purchase litter box scoop
- New queen mattress for Amanda
