The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. **A Review of Technology needs for the individual served:** *Ernie has a walker and a cane but chooses not to use them. He wears a brace on his left foot. Ernie wears 2.0 liters oxygen at night. He owns and rides an electric bike. Ernie wears a GPS life alert watch when he is in the community.*

*Ernie's outcome of participating in social outings was reviewed. In the past 6 months Ernie has participated in 8 social outings. He enjoys visiting and spending time with his peers.*

This person has come to his house to help Ernie clean his yard and have pizza with. Ernie and this same individual have also met at the Argyle American Legion to have a pop and share a pizza for supper. Staff encourage healthy hygiene habits to allow for him to maintain and build peer relationships. Ernie has agreed to take a shower 2x/week during the summer months.*

What are the opportunities **for community access, participation, and inclusion** in preferred community activities?

*MCGH will assist Ernie in accessing the community for his needs regarding shopping and medical appointments and outings that Ernie would like to participate in.*

What are the opportunities to **develop and strengthen personal relationships** with other persons of the person's choice in the community? *Ernie will be encouraged to participate in In-Home outings such as bowling, movies, special events; especially those outings that he has expressed an interest in.*

What are the opportunities to seek **competitive employment** and work at competitively paying jobs in the community?

*Ernie is 59 years old and states he has no desire to work as he was in an accident in 1990 and suffered a brain injury.*

**Health:** *Ernie's medical appointments were reviewed. He has an appt with Megan Weddingfeld, NP at Rural Psych Associates at 10:45a today. This appt is via telehealth at the MCGH office. Cindy will ask Megan if there is anything we can do to help Ernie with his anxiety when he runs out of nicotine lozenges and it cannot be refilled for another 2 weeks. Theresa Nelson agreed to keep Ernie's nicotine lozenges at her home and she will bring him 4 lozenges daily (per the prescription). Ernie was initially upset with this decision but then did reluctantly agree. Liz continues to fill Ernie's weekly medication boxes every Wednesday. Ernie received a flu vaccine and a COVID vaccine on 10/07/24 from NVPH. He is scheduled for the NVPH Foot Care Clinic in November at the Argyle Senior Center. The director of the center always calls Ernie to remind him of the appt.*

**IHS Program:** *Liz reported that everything is going well when working with Ernie. He would like to continue with his outcome to engage in community outings.*

**Chore Services:** *Theresa Nelson has been working with Ernie in cleaning the main level of his home. The bathroom, kitchen, living room and bedroom all look clean and there are no miscellaneous items on the floor. Very nice to see. Theresa will be taking Ernie to shop for a new living room chair. Liz will contact the Argyle City Office to ask if the old chair is tagged properly on the city berm will the City remove the chair.*

**Home:** *Ernie's kitchen cabinet doors, kitchen walls were painted. The walls need a second coat as the yellow color bled through the white paint and shows. Liz will ask Jeff Anderson for a quote to install the vanity, paint the ceiling, and place a sheet of waterproof board behind the vanity (will do remainder of the bathroom as Ernie's funds allow). Cindy to contact LaBine Electric for an estimate to install the new bathroom light fixture and install a switch for the fixture.*

**Funds:** *Katie told Ernie he has funds available at Argyle Grocers to buy groceries and to charge the Monday meal the grocery store prepares.*

**Other:** *St. Rose Church Bazaar - Ernie would like to buy Theresa Nelson a meal from the bazaar as a "thank you" for everything she does for him. He said he would like to order a meal for himself and Theresa to be delivered to his home and they will eat there together.*

**Rain Gutters:** *Cindy to contact Wade, Sentence to Serve Supervisor to set up a time to clean Ernie's house gutters.*
