The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. This meeting is also intended to determine whether changes are needed to the service plan based on the assessment information, the license holder's evaluation of progress towards accomplishing outcomes, or other information provided by the team.

### **A Review of Technology needs for the individual served:**

Jeanette has a tablet that she uses somewhat independently for entertainment and to communicate with her daughter and family. Jeanette currently has a transport wheelchair and is in the process of getting a powerchair. Following the requested home evaluation, equipment for transfers and ambulation will need to be ordered.

### **A review of the person's service and support outcomes occurred and the following determinations regarding those outcomes were made:**

### **Changes needed to the Support Plan Addendum, Intensive Self-Management Assessment, or other document in the service plan, include, if any:**

**ISSA:** Per her daughter, Jeanette is able to digest small amounts of dairy but uses alternatives for dairy products such as milk, yogurt and cottage cheese. Jeanette can voice to staff if her food is not prepared in a way she is able to eat it or if the pieces are too big or too small. Jeanette relies on staff to prepare her food in a way she is able to eat it.

Jeanette has an enteral feeding that runs overnight. At this time, the equipment has not made it to the house for her to have this feeding. Per her discharge orders, she has been eating 60-90% of the meals and put on a sufficient amount of weight as a result of the enteral feedings.

Jeanette enjoys being in the hot tub. Jeanette requires assistance getting into the tub and is not able swim in deeper water.

Jeanette has a soft voice due to her disease. She is able to be understood by others who are familiar with her. Jeanette is encouraged to utilize her voice so it stays strong. Jeanette is able to understand instructions spoken to her.

Jeanette requires time to process and respond to what is asked of her. She is able to communicate her preferences when asked and given time to respond.

### **Discussion regarding person-centered program planning:**

What are the opportunities to develop and maintain **essential and life-enriching skills, abilities, strengths, interests, and preferences?**

*Jeanette has goals to maintain her strength and independence as long as possible and slow the progression of her disease. Jeanette has opportunities to play games with peers in her home. Independence is encouraged by providing patience in her care so that she has to opportunity to do things herself as she wishes.*

What are the opportunities **for community access, participation, and inclusion** in preferred community activities?

*MCGH will bring Patrick to events in the community he is interested in. He and his housemates attend most community activities.*

What are the opportunities to **develop and strengthen personal relationships** with other persons of the person's choice

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in the community?

*Jeanette does not know anyone in this community yet as she is new here. Staff assist Jeanette in attending local activities that she is interested in.*

What are the opportunities to seek **competitive employment** and work at competitively paying jobs in the community?

*Due to the progression of her disease, Jeanette is not interested in work at this time.*

## **Other meeting discussion notes:**

**Arrival:** Jeanette was transported to the facility by her daughter and POA, Nicole. She is coming from her previous residence, the Good Sam in Lakota, ND. Jeanette has arrived in a transport wheelchair. She is in the process of acquiring a powerchair. Nicole brought much of Jeanette's things with her. She brought her own bedding. She will use the twin hi-lo bed currently in the open bedroom. See full admission inventory for details. Jeanette has another daughter she is close with but does not live near her. Jeanette has grandchildren that are important to her. She has brought a TV with her that will be connected to her daughter's streaming accounts. She has logged her in at this time but she made need to be contacted if something needed to be re-logged in. Jeanette enjoys watching NCIS, Law and Order SVU, and other thrillers. Jeanette has a powered recliner that will be moved to the facility. Jeanette has a tablet that she enjoys using during the day. She also enjoys some card games like Uno and playing Yahtzee.

**Medical:** Jeanette's main diagnosis is Huntington's disease. She sees her specialty doctors at Sanford in Fargo. Her daughter shared that they generally go together, and it is generally a whole day's worth of appointments. Going forward, the DCC or DCA will plan to attend with her as they are able. Jeanette's primary care provider is at Altru in East Grand Forks. Jeannette's daughter, Nicole, assists her with the majority of her medical appointments.

Jeanette is up to date on her vaccinations. According to medical records, she is due for a mammogram but her and her daughter have chosen for her to discontinue getting mammograms at this time due to her illness. She will receive manual breast exams from the nurse at the facility and have any concerns followed up on with her primary care provider.

Jeanette has come to the facility with orders to receive enteral feedings through the night to maintain her nutrition.

However, she did not arrive with the enteral feeding pump she was using at the nursing home. PD will follow up with

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orders to get her the equipment needed. Program RN and LPN will go through medications that she arrived with and coordinate them with the orders she has. Jeanette's daughter has shared Jeanette's MyChart information with the PD and RN so that they are able to communicate with her PCP to clarify orders as needed. Due to her disease and her degenerative spine, Jeanette has chronic pain that is managed with her hydrocodone. This will require a double lock and to be counted by two staff 3 times daily.

Jeanette is able to communicate her needs. She is willing to repeat herself if you don't understand her the first time. Jeanette does have a soft voice sometimes and needs to be reminded to speak up occasionally. Jeanette is generally pretty easy-going and go with the flow. When she is having a bad day, generally due to pain, she benefits from some additional 1:1 time such as playing a card game together.

**ADL's:** Jeanette requires some assistance with all of her ADLs. She is able to state her wants answer questions regarding her cares. With physical assistance holding her shirt, she is able to push her arms through her sleeves. When Jeanette is at full strength, she is able to bear weight to stand to transfer or allow for her pants to be pulled up. Jeanette can tell staff when she is in need of using the restroom but needs assistance to get there. She may require assistance lowering her pants and brief. She prefers to have privacy but assistance acquiring the toilet paper needed to wipe. She prefers to wipe herself but needs time to complete the task. She can stand to have assistance will pulling her pants back up and assistance required to wash her hands. Jeanette does not prefer to be toileted at night but will need to be checked and have her brief changed as needed. Jeanette requires full assistance with showers, meal prep and laundry. Jeanette is able to feed herself and can voice if her food is not prepared correctly for her to eat it.

**Needs:** To summarize, Jeanette does not have a feeding pump that she was previously using. She is waiting on her own powerchair. She may require her own walker. OT will see her to evaluate her transfers and ambulation in the home and to assess her equipment needs. Jeanette does not currently have an order for briefs but requires them to be able to be changed by one staff in the overnight hours.
