SERVICE PLAN REVIEW MEETING AND ATTENDANCE NOTES

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. This meeting is also intended to determine whether changes are needed to the service plan based on the assessment information, the license holder's evaluation of progress towards accomplishing outcomes, or other information provided by the team.

A Review of Technology needs for the individual served: *Kevin wears prescription eyeglasses, has a medication dispensing machine installed in his home and a cell phone he uses independently.*

A review of the person's service and support outcomes occurred and the following determinations regarding those outcomes were made:

Kevin's goal to learn to cook and/or bake will continue as written.

Kevin's goal to participate in community outings monthly will continue as written.

Changes needed to the Support Plan Addendum, Intensive Support Self-Management Assessment, or other document in the service plan, include, if any: *SP Addendum: Scope of Services – Kevin no longer receives MOMS Meals. Supports - Staff will provide services once weekly and twice every other week. ISSMA: Health & Needs – Added that Dr. Corey Edwards has prescribed Kevin 150mg of Primidone BID to help reduce his Intention Hand Tremors. Kevin was diagnosed with ADHD following neuro-psych testing with Dr. Susan Thompson, Neuro-Psychologist. Independent Living Skills - Kevin has been able to maintain the cleanliness of his home with supports from IHS. Financial – Kevin receives his paycheck from work done at the Falls DAC and keeps this in a safe place in his home. Vocational -Kevin states he likes his janitorial work at the Falls DAC and in the community of Thief River Falls. IAPP: No changes were made to Kevin's IAPP during this meeting.*

Other meeting discussion notes:

Health: *Please see the attached Physician Order Log for a list of Kevin's medical appointments and a list of his current medications. When Kevin saw Dr. Edwards Nurse Practitioner on 11/12/24 it was suggested that Kevin try using weighted eating utensils and a weighted wristband as a way to minimize his tremors while he is eating. IHS Staff to look on-line for these products and send the links to MCSS to order. There was no change in his Primidone 150mg BID. Kevin's last dental exam was on 5/22/24; he is due for another exam. IHS Staff to call Spectra Dental to make an appt as soon as possible as dentist's are scheduling out quite a few months right now. He reports he is drinking one energy drink/day and is drinking more powerade drinks. Continues to drink instant decaffeinated coffee. IHS Staff will take Kevin for his first Shingles vaccine.*

IHS Outcomes: *Kevin's outcomes will continue as written. To be reviewed at his Semi-Annual Meeting. Informally, IHS Staff will encourage Kevin to fold his laundry as he currently puts in his laundry basket, not folding it.*

IHS: *MaryKay reported that she has been assisting and encouraging Kevin to complete housekeeping tasks. She also encourages him to drink his milk as there are several sour containers in the fridge. When grocery shopping, encourage*

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Kevin to use a shopping list – and to check the amount of lunch meat he has before buying more. There have been several open packages in his fridge and unopened packages that are outdated. Katie will be adding a 2:1 ratio to Kevin's Service Agreement for 4 outings/year, 6 hours/outing = 96 units.

ODC: Following a discussion with Kevin and his IDT – Kevin decided to terminate his services with the TRF ODC. Discharge paperwork was completed at the meeting by Amber Arlien, TRF ODC.

Falls DAC: Kevin stated he likes attending the Falls DAC and he has friends there that he likes to spend time with and visit. And he likes the outings he has gone on. Lynae, DAC Staff reported that Kevin is rushing through his janitorial jobs at the DAC and in the community. Staff have been prompting him to slow down and do a thorough job. Kevin stated he is ordering a burgundy DAC polo shirt. He usually brings a cold sandwich and chips for lunch and buys a pop there.

Other: Kevin talked about his cat, Dorothy, and said she is good company. He stated he has to keep her litter box clean otherwise she will not use it and goes on the floor next to the litter box.

Actions: Send current medication list to Katie Benson

Order weighted eating utensils and wristband

Take Kevin for a Shingles Vaccine

Schedule a dental exam

Quarterly Meeting: 02/11/25 at 9a at Kevin's residence
