The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. This meeting is also intended to determine whether changes are needed to the service plan based on the assessment information, the license holder's evaluation of progress towards accomplishing outcomes, or other information provided by the team.

A Review of Technology needs for the individual served: *Hailey has an iPad she enjoys using for her own entertainment. She has no additional technology needs at this time.*

A review of the person's service and support outcomes occurred and the following determinations regarding those outcomes were made: *Hailey's current outcome focuses on her exploring leisure interests by choosing a leisure activity to do at the group home weekly. She does not have any interest in doing this outcome and has her preferences to work on sketching pictures and making handcrafted I-phones. Hailey and the team talked about a different outcome that Hailey would like to do. It was decided that Hailey will participate in an outing 1x/month 1:1 with staff. This outcome will be written and implemented.*

Changes needed to the Support Plan Addendum, Self-Management Assessment, or other document in the service plan, include, if any: *SP Addendum – Current outcome was discontinued; a new outcome will be written and implemented (see above). Services and Supports: General Supports – Staff will not draw attention to Hailey's compulsive behaviors of repetitive eye blinking and more recently, licking random things at home, at school and in the community. List of Service Providers updated. Health Needs: Hailey's PCP recently increased Hailey's dose of Prozac from 10mg to 20mg to assist in decreasing/eliminating her compulsive licking behavior. IAPP – No changes made. SMA – Self-Management of Symptoms or Behaviors: Hailey recently started licking random items - the table, a container, a wall, etc. This is a behavior that her parents report she has not done for many years. Hailey's primary care physician increased Hailey's Prozac from 10mg to 20mg to see if this will help Hailey reduce the compulsive behavior of licking things. Parents stated they noted the licking behavior started after Hailey saw her alleged sexual abuse perpetrator at the trial. Hailey is seeing a therapist for Play Therapy at the Center for Violence Intervention due to the sexual abuse. List of attendees and date of meeting updated on all plans.*

Discussion regarding person-centered program planning:

What are the opportunities to develop and maintain **essential and life-enriching skills, abilities, strengths, interests, and preferences?** *Hailey continues to attend her local high school, Warren/Alvarado/Oslo, for the 2024-2025 school year. Together with her parents, she chose what classes she wanted to enroll in. She will be encouraged to participate in and assist in planning activities she enjoys when she is living at Cedar North – drawing, church, shopping, baking, crafts, meal prep, being read to and learning board/yard games.*

What are the opportunities **for community access, participation, and inclusion** in preferred community activities? *Hailey participates in horse therapy 1x/week during the summer/fall months; she likes to participate in Park River Bible Camp; enjoys shopping. Staff will assist Hailey in participating in activities of her choice.*

What are the opportunities to **develop and strengthen personal relationships** with other persons of the person's choice in the community? *Hailey will be invited to all Marshall County Group Home events: annual picnic, fall party/dance,*

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etc. She also spends time with her family members. Hailey has some friends at her high school and church.

What are the opportunities to seek **competitive employment** and work at competitively paying jobs in the community? *Hailey had an IEP meeting at the school with Voc Rehab Services in attendance. A discussion was held that Hailey may possible attend the Polk County DAC in East Grand Forks and receive Voc Rehab Services in seeking employment.*

Describe any further research or education that must be completed before a decision regarding this transition can be made: *Hailey had an IEP meeting at the school with Voc Rehab Services in attendance. A discussion was held that Hailey may possible attend the Polk County DAC in East Grand Forks and receive Voc Rehab Services in seeking employment.*

Other meeting discussion notes:

Health: *See the attached report prepared by Henrietta Linder, Residential RN. Upcoming appt: Annual Physical with Dr. Susan Zewlewski on 2/5/25. Parents will ask Dr. Zewlewski to look at the reddened area above Hailey's coccyx as it is not improving with ointments applied. She will be establishing care with another physician after she turns 21- Dr. Haylay Svedjan, Altru Professional Center. Hailey's parents report that Hailey will continue with counseling at the CVIC weekly. Her parents transport her to most of these appointments and will ask CN staff to transport if they are unable to. Custom shoe inserts – parents will contact Altru Orthotics Technician to determine if new inserts are needed. Robert, Hailey's father, agreed to email Cindy a copy of all physician notes/orders following all appts. Staff are asked not to draw attention to Hailey's eye blinking and licking random items as this seems to increase the behavior. Parents stated they feel the licking behavior started after the sexual abuse trial and Hailey saw her perpetrator. This is a behavior she has not exhibited in many years. Hailey regularly sees a Cardiologist due to a genetic heart disorder that her biological father had.*

School/Day Services: *Hailey's parents plan to send her to school until the Winter break before her 22nd birthday and then she will not return to school after the holidays that year. During Hailey's recent IEP meeting at the school, a discussion was held regarding Hailey possibly attending the Polk County DAC after finishing school. Parents gave their verbal permission that Cassi, Case Manager could send the group home a copy of Hailey's IEP.*

Group Home: *Hailey has adjusted very well to living at the group home and her mother stated it is like having an "apartment" just like her older siblings. She gets along well with her housemates. Carol, DCC stated that Hailey is very comfortable at the home and will readily make her own lunch or supper if she decides she does not like the meal that was prepared by staff. She enjoys watching "Dancing with the Stars" with her housemates.*

HAILEY KLEVEN ANNUAL MEETING 1/29/2025

Hailey's semi-annual meeting was held on 7/17/24. Hailey attended horse therapy weekly throughout the summer months. She has attended play therapy at the Community Violence Intervention Center since 5/15/24 for reported sexual abuse which was 2x/weekly thru 8/29/24 then decreased to 1x/weekly. Hailey's parents continue to take her to the appointments but have on occasion requested staff to take her.

Hailey continues to have a good appetite. There are times she dislikes what is being served and staff will offer her an alternative or she chooses to make something for herself. Hailey's weight during a physical exam prior to admit was 170lbs. Her weight on 1/30/24 was 154.3lbs and on 1/3/25 it was 156.7lbs. Hailey's blood pressures have been within normal range. She received a flu vaccination on 10/4/2024.

Hailey will continue to have occasional hives which are mild and respond well to the Benadryl spray. On 7/25/24 she had several blotches noted on one arm and her upper chest stating she felt anxious but not why; on 7/29/24 she had several blotches on her upper chest, hand and back and on 9/20/24 a few blotches were noted on the back of her legs and on one arm stating she was anxious about her sister being loud at school. On 1/14/25 during shower staff noted a nickel size red area above her coccyx which has healed. Also noted several red marks on different areas of her body – Hailey stated the marks were from being anxious due to her sister yelling at school.

On 8/14/24 thru 8/17/24 Hailey began by having a low-grade elevated temp of 99.4 with a dry cough and seemed to have no energy but improved each day receiving OTC meds such as Sudafed, Tylenol and Robitussin. On 8/19/24 she was taken by parents to see her PCP for a physical exam. Her PCP diagnosed her with reactive airway disease and ordered Albuterol inhaler PRN for cough and wheezing. She is to return on 2/5/25.

On 9/24/24 she had a dental appointment with no cavities noted but had a considerable amount of plaque recommending more staff assist with dental cares.

On 10/3/24 she requested Tylenol for tummy discomfort. She also requested Tylenol for an upset tummy on 11/14/24 and again on 1/9/25. I am wondering if using an antacid like Tums or Maalox might work better for an upset stomach.

On 10/5/24 staff noted a lot of blinking of her right eye and at times the eye would close; she also had a lot of blinking and squinting of her eyes on 11/26/24. She continues on Refresh drops for dry eyes and Olopatadine drops for eye allergy.

She required use of the Albuterol inhaler on 10/5/24 and on 10/29/24 for cough. On 12/3 to 12/6/24 she was home from school due to not feeling well with low grade elevated temp and cough which resolved.

On 10/23/24 Hailey was hit on her shoulder by a student at school with no injuries reported. On 11/11/24 the school requested Hailey bring only one cellphone to school which she has complied to. On 11/14/24 the school reported that she had been licking different things at school – at the evening meal that day she began licking the table and was redirected. On 12/2, 12/12/24, 1/7, 1/15, and 1/24 she began licking the table during the supper meal and stopped with redirection. She was also noted to lick the shower head during her shower on 1/24/25. On 1/8/25 Hailey began crying when home from school (it was stated in communication book that she had been talked to about licking things at school) and when she heard her sister yelling next door she started crying even more. Staff went with Hailey to her room and spoke with her which seemed to settle her and she gave staff a big hug.

On 11/15/24 while walking on the deck to get to the school bus. Hailey fell. When she returned from school that day staff noted a quarter size bruise on her left hip – she denied pain in area.

On 12/9/24 Hailey told staff she didn't want to go to school because her sister yells. Staff talked it through with her and she did go to school. The following day on 12/10 she appeared very stand-offish at the facility Christmas party and appeared to not be enjoying herself. When approached, she told staff she misses Mary from school (she retired). On 12/7/24 she requested a Tylenol for a headache. She stated she became very upset at school and had to go into another room because her sister was yelling and stated she wishes they wouldn't say trigger words at school.

Hailey spent time with her two sisters, Kaitie and Kirsten, from 1/4/25 to 1/5/25. They attended a UND hockey game and she stated she had a good time. Hailey continues to have regular visits at home with her parents.

On 1/7/25 she came out of the bathroom after her evening shower and told staff there was poison in her deodorant. Staff told her that was not likely as she has been using the same deodorant for a long time. She seemed satisfied with that response.

Hailey's last appointment with Altru Orthotics was on 8/28/23 - how often does she see orthotics? Hailey's last appointment with cardiology was on 11/13/23. How often does she see cardiology? No lab work was noted to be done in 2024.
