Amanda stated she washed bedding in hot water, vacuumed and cleaned areas that public health stated needed to be done to rid the bed bugs. Amanda bought a new mattress for her room. Amanda states that she might tart working more hours at work and that she received a 2.00 per hour raise in pay. Amanda would like to work on decluttering and cleaning out storage unit as she stated most of it is her son's and ex-daughter in laws and they are coming to get what is thiers.

Medical: Amanda is due for dental but trying to find a place to get in with her insurance

Family: Amanda lives with her son at the home, spends time with her mom and other family members

MCGH: services have been temporarily suspended the past few weeks due to bed bugs, when bed bugs are clear and Public health has been back for a recheck in-home will resume services. Amanda would like her goals to stay the same, especially working on decluttering and organizing .

- Work on declutter/organizing
- Work on cleaning out storage unit
