The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for support team or expanded support team members to participate in the ongoing review and development of the service plan and the methods used to support the person and accomplish outcomes. This meeting is also intended to determine whether changes are needed to the service plan based on the assessment information, the license holder's evaluation of progress towards accomplishing outcomes, or other information provided by the team.

**A Review of Technology needs for the individual served:** *Robert wears prescription eyeglasses, leg wraps, a right ankle brace and a life alert necklace.*

**A review of the person's service and support outcomes occurred and the following determinations regarding those outcomes were made:** *Robert's outcomes/goals were reviewed. Following a discussion with Robert and his team it was decided to continue with his current outcome of preparing a meal. His outcome focusing on leisure interest will be revised so that Robert will be learning how to use his GrandPad to play games on it.*

SP Addendum: The following updates/changes were made to Robert's SP during his Annual Meeting: Services and Supports: Outcome - Robert will explore the games/activities that are on his GrandPad at home and are of interest to him. Robert has a GrandPad that he received through his insurance plan. He uses it as a clock, to play music and it also has games on it he can access.*

What are the opportunities to develop and maintain **essential and life-enriching skills, abilities, strengths, interests, and preferences**? *Robert chooses to attend the ODC, Inc. in Warren, MN; he enjoys visiting at several local businesses in Argyle on a daily basis; he has friends he likes to cook meals with and spend time with visiting. Robert lives in a rented home independently.*

What are the opportunities **for community access, participation, and inclusion** in preferred community activities? *Robert is in the IHS Program which provides him services promoting socialization, leisure activities of his choice and inclusion in community activities.*

What are the opportunities to **develop and strengthen personal relationships** with other persons of the person's choice in the community? *Robert is very active in his community, he is a member of the Argyle Lions Club, he is an active member of Our Saviors Lutheran Church in Argyle, he participates in most community events and outings that are provided by the Individualized Home Supports (IHS) Program such as the MCGH Christmas Party, Summer Picnic and Halloween Party.*

What are the opportunities to seek **competitive employment** and work at competitively paying jobs in the community? *Robert currently attends the ODC, Inc. in Warren, MN. He has the choice to seek competitive employment if he chooses to do so through ODC services.*

**Health:** *Robert's health and medical appointments for the past year were reviewed as well as his current medications (see attached Appointment and Results List). He is currently receiving 5 Home Delivered Meals/week. Due for an eye exam in 8/25; dental appt on 9/23/25. Robert's sister, Marlene, asked if Robert would ask his PCP if there is an alternate medication for high cholesterol, other than Simvastatin. Krissy asked for Robert's lab results from 6/10/25 and 9/24 for his appt with Dr. Tsilbulsky, Psychiatrist– Cindy will send this information to Krissy.*

**IHS Program:** *Robert has participated in several outings with IHS Program – bowling, out to eat, spending time with friends in Warren, attending county parades, and Christmas Party. Liz reported that Robert goes to the Food Shelf x1/month in Argyle. He chooses foods that he likes and uses his air fryer quite a bit. She said he does clean his house partially on his own and with some assistance from Liz.*

**IHS Outcomes:** *Person-centered outcomes were discussed with Robert during the meeting. He stated he would like to continue with his cooking outcome and work on learning/developing more leisure interests by learning how to play games on his GrandPad.*

**ODC:** *Robert is attending the ODC four days/week (Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs). He is transported through Tri-Valley Transportation. Jenna Sieracki, Program Specialist reviewed Robert's goals at the ODC are to exercise for 15 minutes daily, set up music with staff assistance and work on an art project. Robert stated he would like to clean the Argyle Mall – Jenna responded that*

**Family:** *Robert's sister and cousin will be taking Robert to the Marshall County Fair this weekend. Sheran confirmed with Robert that his nephew, Scottie Hurst, would be staying at his home during the fair (Wednesday-Sunday). Robert told Sheran that a good time to call him at home is around 6:55am.*
