Day 12: **State Exam** after clinical

Students must maintain an 80% average on all written exams in order to pass the theory portion of the program prior to entering the clinical component of the program. Students are given the opportunity to retake exams if necessary, to improve their grade. If after one retake they are unable to maintain an 80% average they would then be dismissed from the program.

The Final Competency Exam is comprised of 75 multiple choice questions. Students are allotted 1 ½ hours to complete the exam. The date of the exam can be found on the class calendar. **A score of 90% or greater is necessary on the final competency exam in order to pass the course.** Students are given the opportunity to retake the final competency exam up to two times. If after two retakes they are unable to achieve a score of 90% or greater they must retake the course.
