Structure

- **provides predictability**
- **chain of command, hierarchy**



Key Features (cont'd)

Communication networks

- **formal and informal links between members of organizations**
- **virtual networks**





Key Features (cont'd)

- Links to external environments

- **systems in which organizations exist influence communication in organizations**
- **Must look inside and OUTSIDE organizations to understand their operations**

Organizational Culture

Ways of thinking, acting, and understanding work that are shared by members of an organization and that reflect an organization's distinct identity





Organizational Culture

- Relationship between communication and organizational culture
 - **Member communication creates and sustains organizational culture, while organizational culture influences members' patterns of communication**

Vocabulary

- Hierarchical language
 - **distinguishes levels of status among members**
Mr., Mrs., Sir, Ma'am, Professor, Dr., etc.
- Masculine language
 - **related to men's traditional interests and experiences**
homerun, ballpark estimate, plan of attack, get the big guns, etc.

Rites and Rituals

- Rites

- **dramatic, planned sets of activities that bring together aspects of an organization's culture in a single event**

- Rites of passage

- Rites of integration

- Blaming rites

- Enhancement rites

- Renewal rites

- Conflict resolution rites

Rites and Rituals (cont'd)

- Rituals

- **repeated communication performances that communicate a particular value or meaning**

- Personal rituals
- Social rituals
- Task rituals





Structures

- Roles
 - **responsibilities and behaviors expected of people because of their specific positions**
- Rules
 - **patterned ways of interacting**
 - Constitutive
 - Regulative



Structures (cont'd)

Policies

- **formal statements of practices that reflect and uphold the overall culture of an organization**

Communication networks

- **links formed through formal and informal forms of interaction and relationship**
