## HOW TO UPLOAD YOUR VIDEO & ENTER YOUR COMMENTS ON YOUTUBE

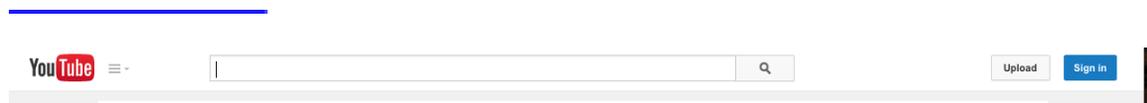

### BEFORE YOU BEGIN...

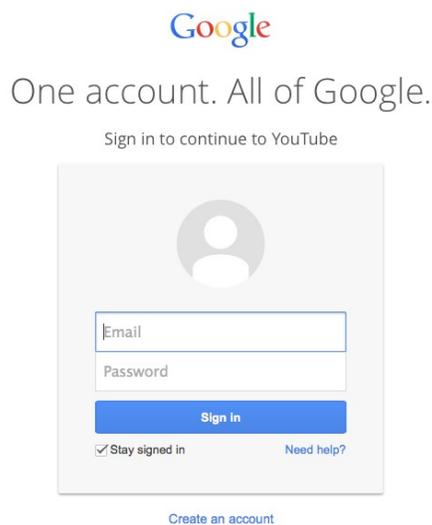
- You must have a Gmail account in order to upload a video on YouTube.
- If you do not have a Gmail account, you can create one during this process.
- Make sure you know where your video file is stored on your computer.

1. Open a web browser and go to [www.youtube.com](http://www.youtube.com)
2. Look at the top-right corner of the YouTube website. Click on “Sign In”. [See below]



3. Enter your Gmail log-in information and click “Sign in”. [See below] \*If you do not have a Google account, click on “Create an account”.

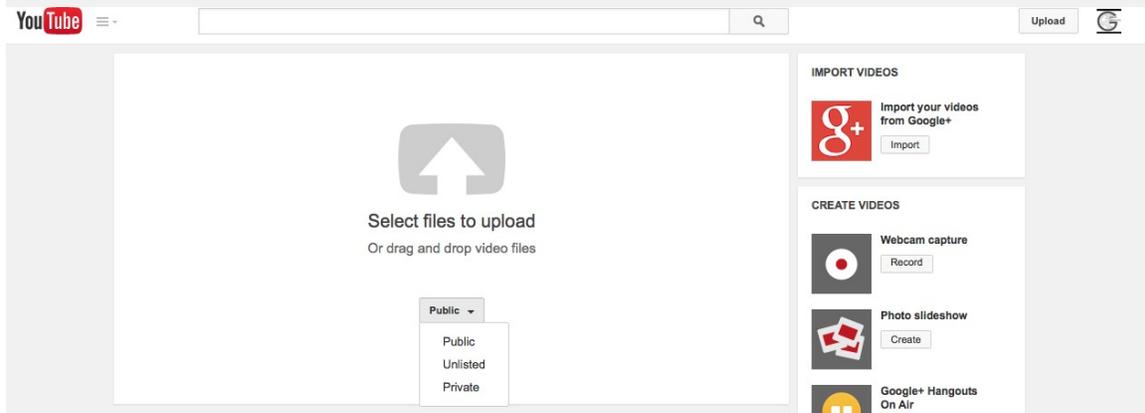
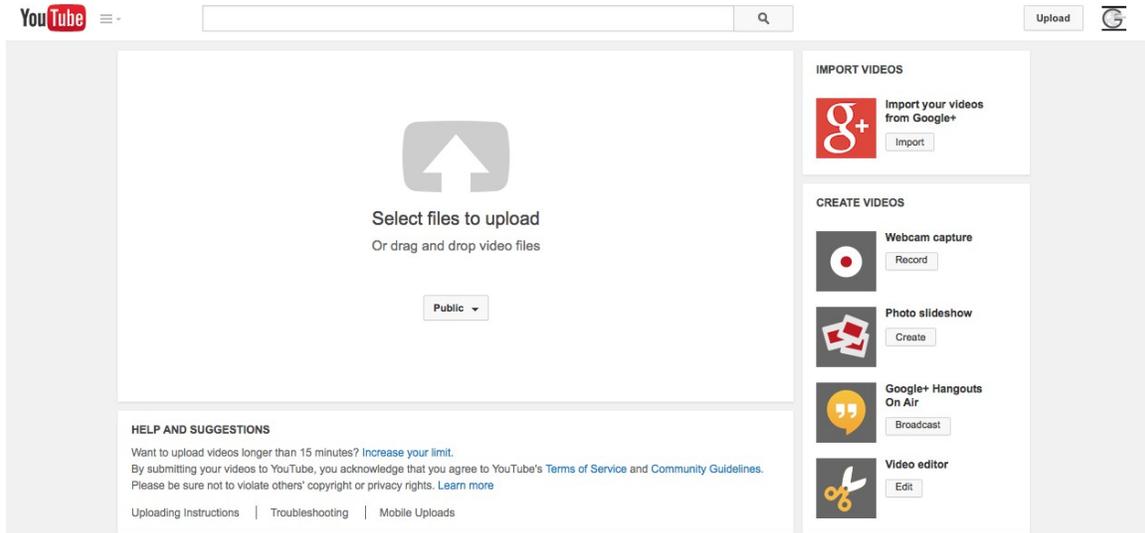


4. After logging in, look at upper-right corner and click on “Upload”. [See below]



5. Look at the middle of the screen and click on “Public”. [See below]

6. When you click on “Public”, three options will appear: “Public”, “Unlisted” and “Private”. [See below]



7. Click “Unlisted”. Then click on “Select files to upload”. Look for your video file and double-click it.

8. There will be a progress bar at the top of the screen showing the upload progress. The progress bar will first say “Uploading” along with a percentage of the file that’s been uploaded. Then it will say “Processing” along with a percentage of the file that’s been processed. [See below]

9. When the video file has been completely uploaded and processed, it will say “Processing Done”. Press “Done”. [See below]
