TERM PROJECT INSTRUCTIONS

Choose a Discussion topic that you have written about in this class that you would like to further explore and write a 1000 word paper (about 3 1/2 pages) on the topic. The paper will need to have three (3) scholarly articles, which have been published within the previous 5 years (2014 to the present), reviewing the three (3) articles. **Each of the scholarly articles must be a narrative on the results of a study/research.** Consider basing your review of the articles around one or more of the following questions (though addressing all of these questions is not required):

- What are the common themes among the findings of all 3 research articles?
- What are the differences among the findings of all 3 of the research articles?
- What is unique in each article regarding the author's approach to the concept?
- According to the authors of the articles, why is the concept important to an organization's leadership?

Use MLA style to cite and document your sources

Paper Requirements:

- The paper is to be your original work and written solely for this course. Although past papers can be minimally referenced, papers previously submitted or work from previously submitted assignments cannot be used to fulfill this assignment.
- The paper must be written using MLA format and include and a works cited list.
- The paper must have a minimum of 1000 words (and a maximum of 1100 words). The word count does not include the works cited page.

- Each article must be a **primary source from a peer-reviewed journal** published within the past 5 years. **Each of the articles must be a narrative on the results of a study/research.** Articles that are not based on the findings of a study/research should not be used even if they are in a peer-reviewed, academic journal.
- It must be submitted as a Word document (.doc) (no PDFs please).
- Upload the finished paper to the drop box by the end of Lesson Week 14.
- Block quotes from the referenced articles will not count toward the word count requirement.
- References must be as follows:
 - o 3 peer-reviewed references must be used.
 - Each reference must be from a different peer-reviewed journal published within the past 5 years. **Each of the articles chosen must be a narrative on the results of a study/research.**
 - Textbooks, web blogs, abstracts, dissertations, magazines, and other ancillary materials are not counted as one of the required references.
 - Quotations must not be more than 15% of the paper – paraphrase and properly cite the references.
