

Site visit report 1

As a physical therapist, I have chanced to involve with disable community for physical and mental issues. I would like to introduce the milal mission in NY, which is faith based non-profit organization for people with special needs. Their vision is for evangelism, service, and enlightenment for disable community. Their group home is located at 142-44 bayside Ave, flushing. NY 11354. Group home care and rehab programs currently six clients with learning disabilities. The main center is located at 42-19 bell Blvd., bayside, NY 11361. The milal is an international evangelical movement, which intercedes for people with disabilities all over the world. It was started in 1979 in Korea by blind pastor. The milal in Korean means "wheat grain"- in reference to bible verse john 12:24; "truly, truly I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains by itself alone. But if it dies, it bears much fruit." There are few programs: Saturday class with adult and children disable clients who participates active daily activities by coordinator and volunteer. .the Tuesday worship program is for enlightens, enrichment, and evangelizes for members of community or other people.

I went to this worship service and felt different atmosphere. It is challenging experience to take care of disable people. There are mixtures of unthinkable frustrations and thanks to the God. When I see these people, I regret that I

never appreciated what i have now from God. In terms of urban ministry, we open emphasize poor and social injustice. But there are people who need love and care from society.

Again, who is our neighbor? We never think about people who physical and mental disable. The Church should pay attention not only send missionary for other country but also people near us. We should educate people that reach out other communities with the Christ love. That is true meaning of Gospel form God.
