Answer the Following:

1. Describe in a nutshell the person's life from start to finish

a) King Saul

Before Saul became king, he was a decent person, and he was chosen to rule over the people of God, but God expressed sorrow because of Saul's sinful rebellion.

b) Judas Iscariot

Judas Iscariot never dedicated himself to be a real disciple of Jesus, he was selfish and a dishonest man.

2. How would you classify each person as a follower of God?

Saul was known as God's follower when he told Samuel that blessed are you by the Lord, and Saul had performed the command of the Lord, but through Samuel he defiled and disobeyed the word of God.

Judas Iscariot's focus was never to be a follower of God; he only came to see how much he could benefit from becoming a disciple of Jesus.

3. Describe each person's downfall – what led to it?

Saul was arrogant, but he admitted to Samuel that he had sinned and had transgressed the Lord's command, he said that he was afraid of the people and listened to their voice.

When Judas Iscariot saw the indictment of Jesus, he felt guilty and said, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood."
