

FILM ANALYSIS

The purpose of this exercise is to apply the information you have learned. You are to identify the main themes in the film and provide a critique of the narrative. The students should ask themselves the following questions and provide a thorough discussion of the answers:

1. What are the main themes of the films?
2. What similar themes did you get from the films.
3. How did the producers construct their arguments?
4. Do the producers have a moral, political, and or economic posture? Is it made explicit or implicit?
5. What assumptions do the producers have about American society? Is the portrayal accurate?
6. What aspects or ideas from the videos relate to material covered in the course?
7. What aspects or ideas from the videos exacerbate or helps to create political conflict in the United States?
8. What concepts/principles from the videos relate to contemporary political challenges in the United States?
9. The analysis should be at least 3 (three) pages, double-spaced with font size not larger than 12pt.
