<p>April 6, 7, 9 and 10</p> <p>Because of the COVID-19 virus, my field placement responsibilities have changed. I now have to be the hands and feet for Pastor Corbin since he started doing classes remote. We have to break the class into two groups. Only nine men can come into the main class and the other have to go to the computer room and do lessons to makeup their class time. After 10.15 the men that were in the main classroom move to the computer room and the other move into the main classroom. I arrive 15 minutes early to set up the video. I handout lessons that Pastor Corbin created. I monitor both classrooms and take the attendance for the morning and the afternoon classes. I handout notebooks, pens and other tools that the men need to use to learn.</p>	<p>Everything has completely changed since the outbreak of COVID-19, which made me have to adjust quickly. Classes are still going, but by remote now. This is my second week showing up at the site, my responsibilities were that I had to make sure that all the men that were required to be in class were accounted for. I have to speak with Pastor Perez to make sure that everyone was seated in class. Because of social distance rules, there are two classes and I have to check on both classes to make sure that no one is skipping class. there are assignments that I have to print out and download to hand out to the men. They are to do these assignments in the computer room. From time to time I will share some biblical knowledge, for example Pastor Corbin was teaching on Friday about what good Friday meant to Christians and I shared that His crying out for something to drink because He was thirsty was a Spiritual symbolic meaning and that it meant that He was our atonement and that anyone that came to Him thirsty that He would fulfill our thirst through salvation. I would arrive early to set up the video conference, take attendance and handout the lessons that was printed out.</p>
