#### **Luke 17:1-10**

- Subject: What should we do when someone sins against us and repents?
- Complement: Forgive them each time as a matter of obedience.
- Main Idea: Forgiveness is a matter of obedience.

#### **Isaiah 7:1-17**

- Subject: Where is God in the midst of fearful moments?
- Complement: God is ready to save His people.
- Main Idea: Whether or not we seek God in times of fear, He is ready to save His people.

#### **1 Peter 5:1-4**

- Subject: Why should we serve willingly and sacrificially?
- Complement: In order to receive the unfading crown of glory.
- Main Idea: We should serve willingly and sacrificially for the everlasting reward.

#### **Psalm 131**

- Subject: How do we deal with weighty matters?
- Complement: Humble yourself like a weaned child and choose to go to the Lord. Find comfort in the Lord and put your hope in Him.
- Main Idea: We need to go to the Lord for comfort and hope when dealing with weighty matters.

### **Matthew 18:15-20**

- Subject: How can we remain united when a fellow believer has sinned against us?
- Complement: Seek to peacefully communicate with them alone before getting the church involved.
- Main Idea: We need to seek peaceful reconciliation and unity when a fellow believer sins against us.

### **Esther**

- Subject: What should we do in the face of danger?
- Complement: Don't turn away from God's holy living and seek Him.
- Main Idea: Continue to live a holy life and seek the Lord in the face of danger.

### **Hebrews 13:5-6**

- Subject: How can we find contentment in our life?
- Complement: Focus on God's presence and help.
- Main Idea: We are content because we God is with us and He is our helper.

### **Daniel 4**

- Subject: Why do we fail to remember the sovereignty of God?
- Complement: Our pride causes us to disobey and ignore God.
- Main Idea: We disregard God's sovereignty because of our pride which causes us to disobey and ignore God.

### **Luke 8:1-18**

- Subject: How should we receive the good news of the kingdom of God?
- Complement: Carefully listen to the word of God and hold fast to it so we know the

secrets of the kingdom of God, bear fruit, and share it.

- Main Idea: We are responsible for carefully listening to the word of God so that we grow fruit and share it with others.

### **1 Thessalonians 1:2-10**

- Subject: What impact does the Gospel have on those who believe?
- Complement: It transforms us to be imitators of Jesus and an example for all other believers.
- Main Idea: The Gospel transforms believers to serve God, become imitators of Jesus, and be an example for all other believers.

### **Matthew 18:21-35**

- Subject: Why should we continue to forgive those who continue to sin against us?
- Complement: Because our heavenly Father shows us mercy and repeatedly forgives us.
- Main Idea: We forgive others as we receive forgiveness from our heavenly Father.

### **1 Corinthians 8**

- Subject: How should we live our lives with the knowledge that there is no God, but one?
- Complement: Our knowledge shouldn't separate us from those who don't know or are weaker causing them to stumble, but we should build up others in love.
- Main Idea: With the knowledge that there is only one God, we should build up others in love.
