Passage Analyze

Passage: Luke 17: 1-10
Subject: What should we do when someone sins against us and repents?
Complement: Forgive them each time as a matter of obedience.
Main Idea: Repentance and forgiveness go hand in hand.

Passage: Isaiah 7: 1-17
Subject: What happens when we put the Lord to the test by not trusting His word?
Complement: God humbles those that do not trust Him.
Main Idea: Humility

Passage: 1 Peter 5:1-4
Subject: Why should you shepherd God's flock willingly, eagerly, sacrificially?
Complement: You will receive the Crown of Glory (a reward that never fades).
Main Idea: Suffering for the Glory of God

Passage: Psalm 131
Subject: How do I deal with matters beyond my control?
Complement: Humble myself like a weaned child before the Lord.
Main Idea: Humility

Passage: Matthew 18: 21-35
Subject: Why is it crucial that we forgive like God has forgiven us?
Complement: To not forgive after we have been forgiven is sin and leads to bondage and death.
Main Idea: Forgiveness

Passage: Esther
Subject: How does God protect His people Israel from annihilation?
Complement: Everyone has a role to play in the Kingdom of God.
Main Idea: Providence of God

Passage: Hebrews 13: 5-6
Subject: Why can we trust God over all else?
Complement: God is our helper and will never leave us
Main Idea: You can put your trust in God

Passage: Daniel 4
Subject: Why should those in leadership positions give glory to God?
Complement: God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble (1 Pet 5:5b)

Main Idea: Pride vs Humility

Passage: Luke 8: 1-18

Subject: Why is the way we listen to and receive the Word of God important?

Complement: Listening well to the word of God produces a harvest

Main Idea: The Power of Listening

Passage: 1 Thessalonians 1: 2-10

Subject: What happens when you exhibit genuine love, faith, and joy amid suffering?

Complement: Other people will notice and speak of Christ.

Main Idea: Witness for Christ

Passage: 1 Corinthians 8

Subject: What good is “knowledge” without love?

Complement: “Knowledge” alone may cause a weaker believer to stumble, but love strengthens.

Main Idea: I Am My Brother’s Keeper
