<p>APA Format, 6-8 pages            Followed 7<sup>th</sup> edition, cover letter, introduction, body with headers, conclusion and reference page</p>	<p>The purpose of the introduction is to provide the reader with a road map about what topics the paper will cover. So for example, “Cultural identity is an aspect of everyone’s sense of self. In this paper, I will discuss my background, knowledge, and power privilege...”</p> <p>Be mindful of long paragraphs. Under the “national background” paragraph, you could have started a new paragraph after the first-generation sentence.</p> <p>Reference page should be double spaced</p>	<p>3.5 /5</p>
