

1, He explained the two-state conquest would face the excessive cost of today's weapons systems and the fear of lethal atomic weapons in peaceful terms. Also, he said only for when a nation's armaments would be sufficient beyond doubt can we be certain beyond doubt that they would never be used. 3, For those people living in the huts and villages of half the world striving to break the bonds of universal poverty, he pledge they would take our best efforts to help themselves, no matter how long it takes. Also he explained it was not because their right vote and it was a right thing to do.

4, He urged the citizens of America to ask of themselves in the same high standards of strength and sacrifice. With a good conscience they only sure

them go forth to lead the land they love.
