1. The two initial announcements are normally in the tonic.
2. The closely related keys of E maj are: C# min, A maj, B maj, F# min, G# min, E min.
3. The freer passages are called “episodes.”
4. Two functions of episodes are:
 - To modulate from the key of one statement to the next
 - To provide new interest and a relief from the full statements of the motive

Episodes are based on a portion of the motive or countermotive (or even new material).

5. To determine which keys belong, construct triads on each scale step of the key. Major or minor triads indicate closely related major or minor keys.
6. The accompanying voice can help clarify the key and rhythmic structures.
7. The longest motives in Bach’s inventions are 4 measures
8. An invention is a short contrapuntal work centering around the development of material from 1 or 2 motives.
